## Issaquah Transit Center Parking Garage

**The Issaquah Transit Center parking garage opens for commuters on Monday, July 28, 2008.**

Sound Transit is pleased to announce the opening of the Issaquah Transit Center parking garage with over 800 parking stalls. The new parking garage completes the project.

The interim parking lot located at SR 900 and N.W. Maple Street that was provided during construction will close the evening of Sunday, July 27, 2008. Vehicles remaining in the interim parking lot after the closure must be removed.

The King County Metro operated park-and-ride lots located at Tibbetts Valley Park will remain open for commuter use.

The project doubled the parking capacity and provided improved rider loading areas, additional bus bays, new passenger shelters, bicycle storage equipment and public art.
