EVERETT STATION LAYOVER TRACK EXTENSION

The Central Puget Sound Regional Transit Authority (Sound Transit) invites sealed bids for the Everett Station Layover Track Extension construction project.

Scope of Work includes construction of layover track extension, layover facilities and improvements for the commuter rail train, complete with grading, excavation, retaining walls, paving, installation of under-drains, storm drains, sewer, water, temporary and permanent inter-track fence and perimeter fence, double swing gates, air compressor, wayside power, lighting, and placement of sub-ballast and ballast, installation of track, and coordination with other contractors and all other work as shown in the contract drawings and as specified in the contract specifications.

This may also include optional Work to remove and dispose of unsuitable, contaminated, or hazardous excavated materials and to import and fill or back fill with gravel borrow and/or sub-ballast.

For bidding purposes, the range of this project is between \$1.9 million to \$2.3 million dollars.

There is a **Small Business Goal of 20%**; with a **DBE Goal of 10%**.

Prospective bidders, subcontractors, and suppliers are encouraged to attend a Pre-Bid Conference on **October 21, 2009 at 9:00 a.m.**, at Sound Transit's Ruth Fisher Board Room, 401 South Jackson Street, Seattle, WA. This Conference will be held to discuss the Work to be performed, Small and Disadvantaged Business Participation, and bidding forms and procedures.

Bids shall be delivered to Sound Transit at 401 South Jackson Street, Seattle, WA 98104-2826 with Bid Submittal Number 1 received on or before **11:00 a.m. Seattle time on November 9, 2009**, and Bid Submittal Number 2 received on or before **1:00 p.m. Seattle time, November 9, 2009**.
