## Appendix B Public Involvement

Active public involvement has been an integral component of the Central Link light rail project, including North Link. This appendix summarizes the major public involvement activities that have helped shape the light rail line.

### B.1 PUBLIC INVOLVEMENT GOALS

Sound Transit is committed to working with local public transportation agencies, local jurisdictions, and agencies to create an open public involvement process with ample opportunities to inform and involve the community and seek input through the various design phases. Citizens and groups have extensive opportunities to interact with, and receive a response from, appointed and elected officials on issues of interest or concern. Sound Transit makes every effort to ensure the following:

- Citizens have access to the planning process.
- Citizens' input is actively sought at all stages of planning and development.
- A representative cross section of interests is engaged.
- All programs and activities are publicized, and the proceedings and records made available for public review.
- Citizens have opportunities to influence decisions before they are finalized.
- Citizens' inquiries, suggestions, and ideas are answered or accounted for in the decision-making process.

### B.2 ONGOING PUBLIC INVOLVEMENT ACTIVITIES

#### B.2.1 Community and Neighborhood Meetings and Events

Public outreach efforts for the North Link project include Link meetings from fall of 1997 through publication of the Final SEIS. These efforts are listed in Table B-1.

#### B.2.2 Regular Newsletters and Updates

Sound Transit has continued to provide updates on the light rail project through:

- Sound Transit e-Wave, a quarterly e-mail newsletter distributed to about 4,000 people, provides recipients with information on agency progress and project status.
- Newsletters and project updates mailed and e-mailed to distribution list and posted to website.
- The Sound Transit website provides updated information on the project and other agency activities as well as access to Board resolutions, motions, agendas, and other publications.

#### B.2.3 Fact Sheets

Sound Transit regularly produces geographic, project, or issue-specific fact sheets. These are made available out of the Sound Transit offices, mailed upon request or interest, and distributed at community events. Fact sheets have been regularly provided as part of project design workshops and open houses held following the publication of both the 2003 and 2005 Draft SEIS and through the design phases.

#### **B.2.4 Database**

Sound Transit maintains a database listing of people interested in receiving regular mailings on the agency's progress and is having opportunities for public input. The database is used when preparing mailings in addition to the postal carrier routes, and includes attendees at North Link open houses and public meetings, correspondents and commenters on the 2003 Draft SEIS, the Modified Montlake Addendum, the 2005 Draft SEIS, and others who have requested information on the North Link Project.

Sound Transit continues to expand interest distribution lists and provides community members, stakeholders, property owners, and other interested parties the opportunity to select specific topics such as individual stations or the entire North Link route. The Sound Transit distribution list for North Link contains approximately 4,000 addresses. Individuals can request updates through mail or e-mail.

#### **B.2.5 Citizen Oversight Panel**

Link light rail staff provide regular updates on the North Link project to the Citizen Oversight Panel. This body is a 15-member panel of citizen volunteers appointed by Sound Transit's Board to monitor and report on Sound Transit performance in delivering on the commitments it made in *Sound Move*, approved by the region's voters in November 1996.

The panel reports its findings and areas for suggested improvement to the Sound Transit Board. Panel members are appointed by the Sound Transit Board to serve 2- or 3-year terms. The members represent a variety of interests, professional expertise, and experience. At least two members are appointed from each of the five geographic subareas of the Sound Transit District.

#### **B.2.6 Scoping**

The Central Link EIS process started in 1997 included what is now known as the North Link. Therefore, the scoping and open house meetings held in November and December 1997 and the spring, summer, and winter of 2000 directly addressed the North Link area, although new route options have since been introduced. The specific North Link effort officially began when the Sound Transit Board voted in September 2001 to identify the route to the south as the Initial Segment and to begin a 2-year SEIS process to evaluate the route options to the north.

Although scoping is not required for an SEIS, scoping for the North Link SEIS was conducted. The 2005 Draft SEIS is a continuation of the North Link Environmental process. The scoping effort included mailing over 70,000 postcards to residents and businesses and two public scoping meetings, began in October 2001. A public open house for the North Link area at the beginning of the scoping process notified attendees of the upcoming scoping process. Scoping included the following activities:

- Released the scoping information report on October 8, 2001 describing the proposed alternatives, issues, and the public involvement schedule; this report was made available at the public open houses, the agency scoping meeting, and on the Sound Transit website.
- Sent postcards to over 70,000 residents and businesses to announce the beginning of the scoping process, the public open houses, and the availability of the scoping information report.
- Placed legal notice advertisements in major daily newspaper announcing scoping period.
- Held two evening public scoping meetings (October 24 and 25, 2001) at two different locations in the City of Seattle.
- Held an agency scoping meeting for the convenience of interested and affected agencies.
- Met or corresponded with affected local, regional, state, and federal agencies, tribes, and other organizations regarding issues within their jurisdiction.
- Received and reviewed over 100 written and oral comments made at the scoping meetings or received during the scoping period. Issued a scoping summary report in January 2002. Although the formal comment scoping period ended on November 9, 2001, comments in the scoping summary report include those received through November 30, 2001.

## **B.2.7 Environmental Impact Statement**

Sound Transit has conducted additional activities specifically designed to raise awareness of the impacts of the various route and station locations being considered for analysis in this SEIS. The goal has been to encourage the community to make effective, informed comments both on the SEIS and to the Sound Transit Board. In addition to posting legal notices in the Seattle Times and Daily Journal of Commerce and posting notices in the Federal and/or SEPA Registers, Sound Transit has conducted the following outreach activities for environmental documentation:

### ***2003 Draft SEIS***

- Held two public hearing/open houses for the release of the 2003 Draft SEIS in January 2004. Mailed approximately 90,000 postcards to the Sound Transit mailing list and to carrier routes throughout the North Link alignment. Hung posters at public places such as community centers and libraries near the proposed station locations. Display ads were placed in Seattle Times and local specialty newspapers.

### ***Modified Montlake Route Addendum***

- Held one public meeting in February 2004 for the release of the Modified Montlake Route Addendum. A notification postcard was mailed to approximately 23,000 addresses. This mailing targeted people in the University District and Montlake areas. E-mail notification was sent to people who previously expressed an interest in the project. A display ad was placed in the Seattle Times. Posters were hung at public places such as community centers and libraries near the proposed station locations.

### ***2005 Draft SEIS***

- Held two public hearings/open houses in November 2005 for the release of the 2005 Draft SEIS. Mailed and distributed 67,000 notification postcards to internal mailing lists and to residents/property owners/businesses located approximately one-half mile from the alignment and stations. Display ads were placed in Seattle Times and local specialty newspapers. E-mail notification was sent to people on the internal interested party list. Posters were hung at and additional notification postcards were delivered to neighborhood service centers, libraries and community centers. Community groups and organizations were contacted and asked to include public meeting information on their websites and in newsletters.

In addition to outreach efforts associated with publication of environmental documents, Sound Transit has conducted the following project-related outreach. Specific meetings are listed in Table B-1.

- Held two series of open houses during preliminary engineering. Six open houses were held in October 2004 during the first round in the First Hill, Capitol Hill, Montlake, University District, Roosevelt, and Northgate neighborhoods. A project update, which gave an overview of the project and meeting notification, was mailed to internal mailing lists and to residents/property owners/businesses located one-half mile from the alignment and stations (approximately 67,000 pieces). The project update included a reply card for community members to return with their contact information so that they could be included on future mailings or e-mails. E-mails were sent to an interested parties list, and posters were hung around the University of Washington. Staff also worked with local groups and organizations on listing the meeting notices in newsletters and on local web sites. In addition, display advertisements ran in Seattle and neighborhood-specific newspapers. Three open houses were held in February 2005 during the second round in the Capitol Hill, University District and Roosevelt neighborhoods. Roughly 40,000 postcards were sent to Sound Transit's mailing list, community members who used the reply cards from the previous project update and to residents/property owners/businesses located one-half mile around each station. Additional notification included the same elements as those implemented for the fall 2004 open houses including e-mails, posters, and working with local groups and organizations.

- An additional public meeting was closely coordinated with Roosevelt neighborhood organizations prior to the Sound Transit Board decision of the station location in that neighborhood. The purpose of the meeting was to inform the community ahead of the Board meeting of the same information the Sound Transit Board would be receiving to make its decision. Sound Transit worked with these local organizations on logistics, notification and presentation.
- Attended interest group and community organization's regularly scheduled meetings to provide a project update or specific project related information.
- Contacted impacted residents/property owners/businesses to talk through impacts and provide a project overview.
- Individually contacted community members and stakeholders ahead of Sound Transit Board meetings to proactively inform them of upcoming Board discussion or action.
- Met individually with community members to discuss specific issues or impacts related to the project design.
- Produced updated materials and distributed at open houses and community briefings, and to people requesting specific information or to interested parties. Materials were also turned into web pages on the Sound Transit web site. Materials included project update, fact sheets, and maps.
