## Link Light Rail – Construction Alert International Boulevard Pedestrian Bridge Erection Friday, January 30, 2009/Saturday, January 31, 2009

**On Friday, January 30<sup>th</sup> at 9:00 p.m.** Sound Transit's contractor, Mowat Construction Company, will be erecting a pre-fabricated steel pedestrian bridge that will span both north and southbound International Boulevard and the northbound Airport Expressway. A 550-ton crane with a 116ft boom will be used for this operation and sit in the median of International Blvd to lift and set the bridge in place. This will require a temporary closure of International Blvd. and the northbound Airport Expressway.

### *What you can expect:*

- From **9:00 p.m.\* on Friday, January 30 until 4:00 a.m. on Saturday, January 31**, northbound and southbound International Blvd will be closed between S 170<sup>th</sup> Street and S 176<sup>th</sup> Street.  
*\* Motorists may see traffic control and single lane closures set-up as early as 8:00 p.m.*
- From **11:00 p.m. on Friday, January 30 until 4:00 a.m. on Saturday, January 31**, the northbound Airport Expressway will be closed.
- Access will be maintained for all businesses along the closed section of International Blvd. and customers/deliveries/employees will be aided through the work zone by flaggers.
- A recommended detour will be in place for both north and southbound International Blvd. Please allow extra travel time for traffic changes.

### Northbound International Blvd:

*Right* onto S 176<sup>th</sup> St.

*Left* onto Military Road S

*Left* S. 170<sup>th</sup> St to return to International Blvd.

### Southbound International Blvd:

*Left* onto S. 170<sup>th</sup> St.

*Right* onto Military Road S

*Right* on S. 176<sup>th</sup> St. to return to International Blvd. (see map on reverse).

The northbound Airport Expressway will be closed which will close access to the Airport at S 182nd Street. Southbound Airport Expressway traffic will be diverted to the 'arrivals' deck and traffic detoured onto International Blvd. Rental Car access will be left open and flaggers will be stationed throughout the detour area to assist the traveling public.
