Link Light Rail System

- 16 miles of light rail with 13 stations currently in service
- University Link under construction; opens 2016
- ST2 Plan funded extensions to Overlake, South King County, and Lynnwood
- 54 mile system



North Link (University District to Northgate)

- 4.3-mile light rail extension
- Stations at U-District (Brooklyn), Roosevelt and Northgate
- Completion: 2021
- 62,000 daily boardings added to system by 2030

- Reflect the nature of the environment
- Be brief and easy to read and remember
- Comply with Americans with Disabilities Act and be limited to 30 characters
- Avoid commercial references
- Avoid similar names or words in existing facility names

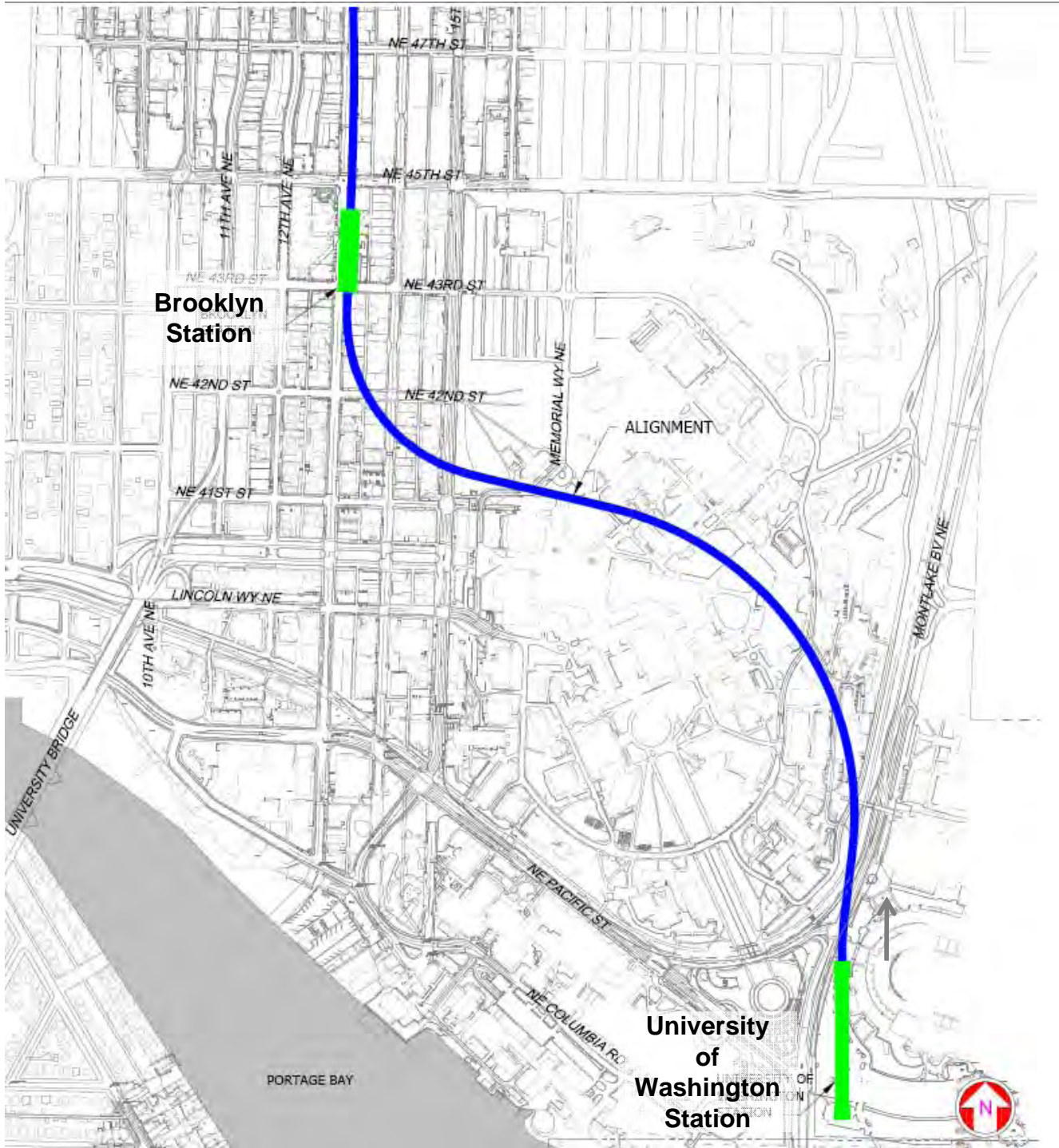

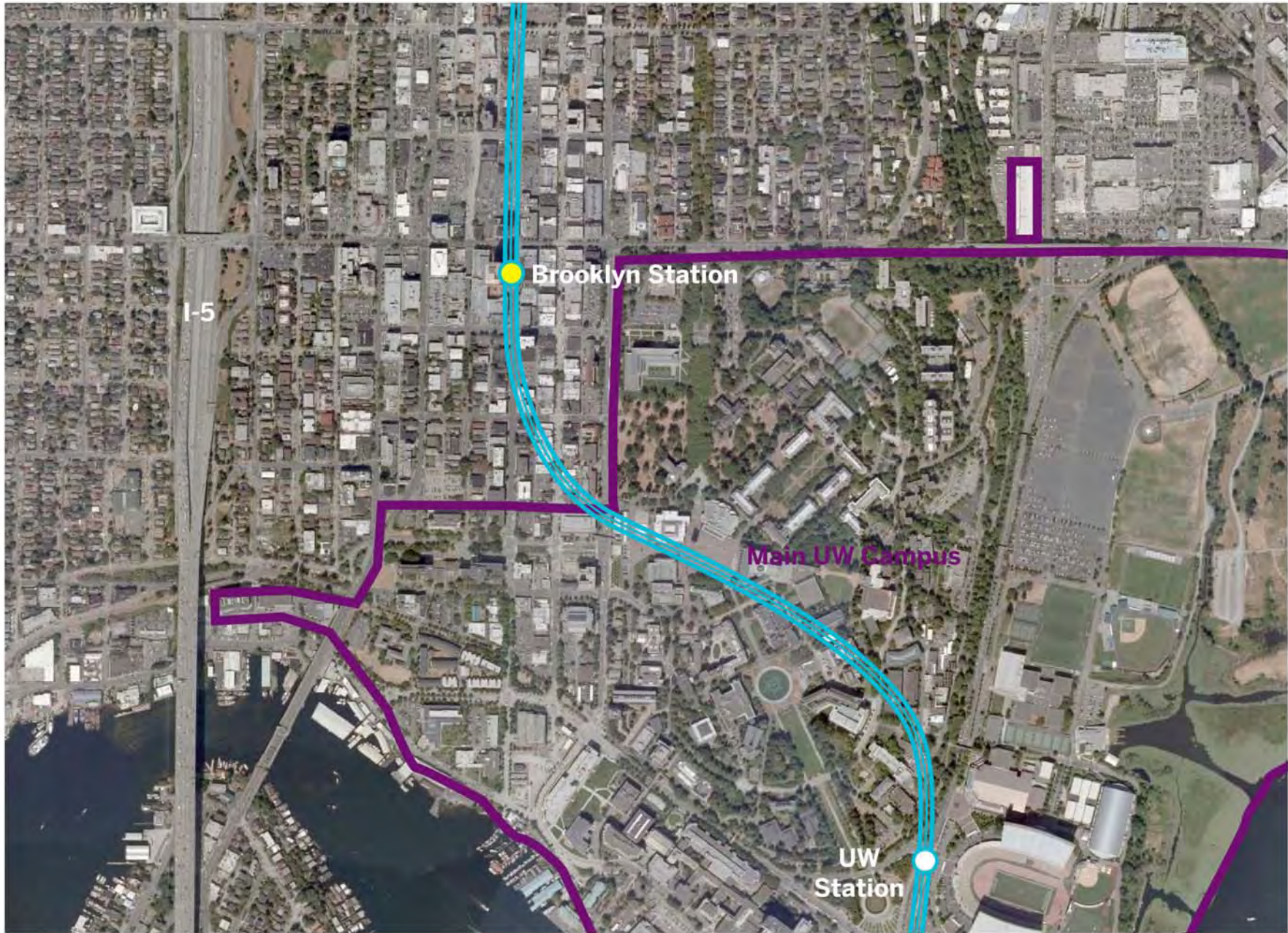
Key Features:

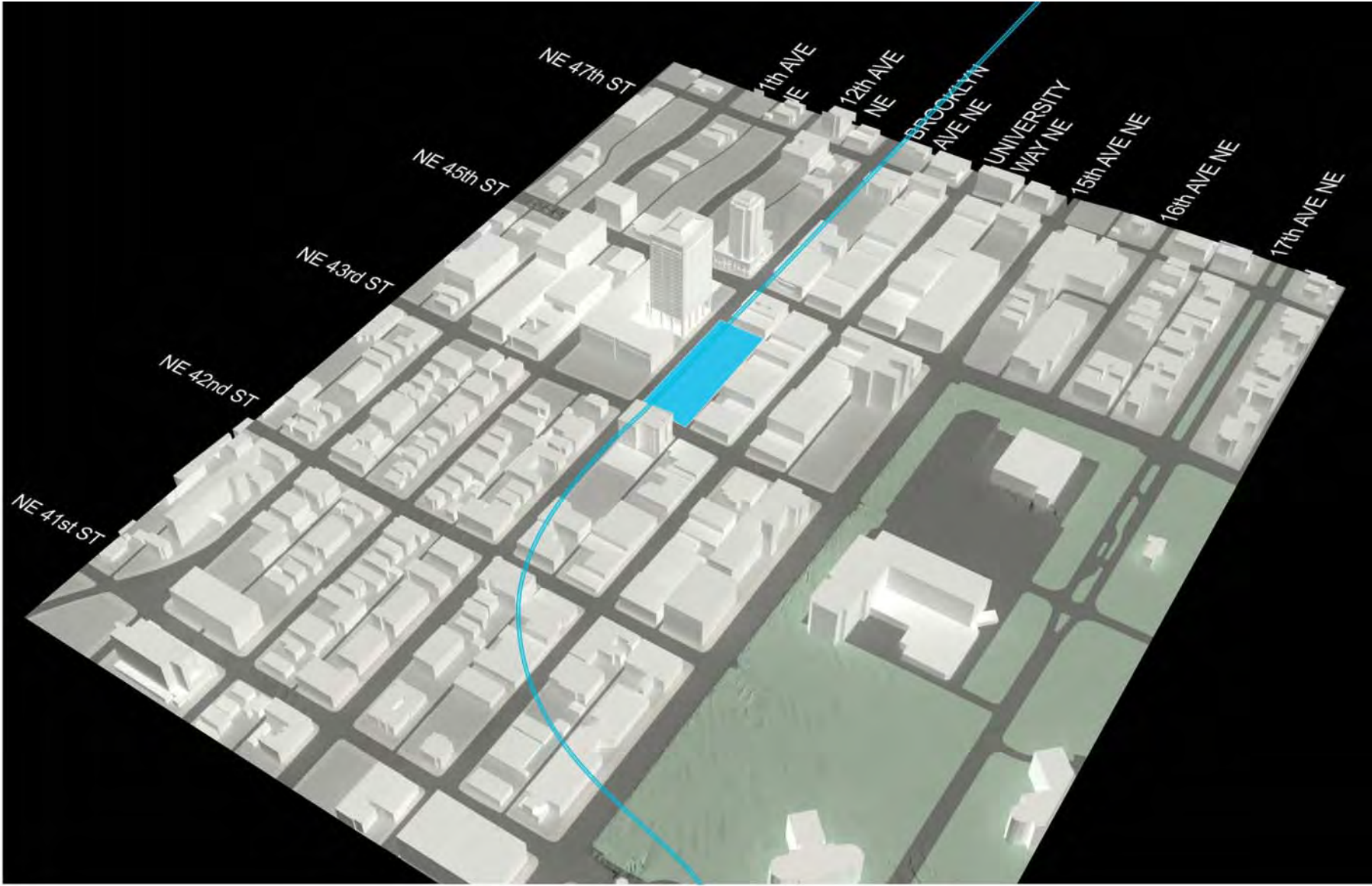
- Station platform, 75-85 ft. underground
 - Elevators, escalators and stairs
 - Bicycle parking
 - 12,000 daily boardings (2030)
- Constrained construction site
- Staging use of Brooklyn Avenue and NE 43rd followed by restoration to City Green Street principles
- Designed to accommodate future building above station
- LRRP reviewed 60% design on May 17

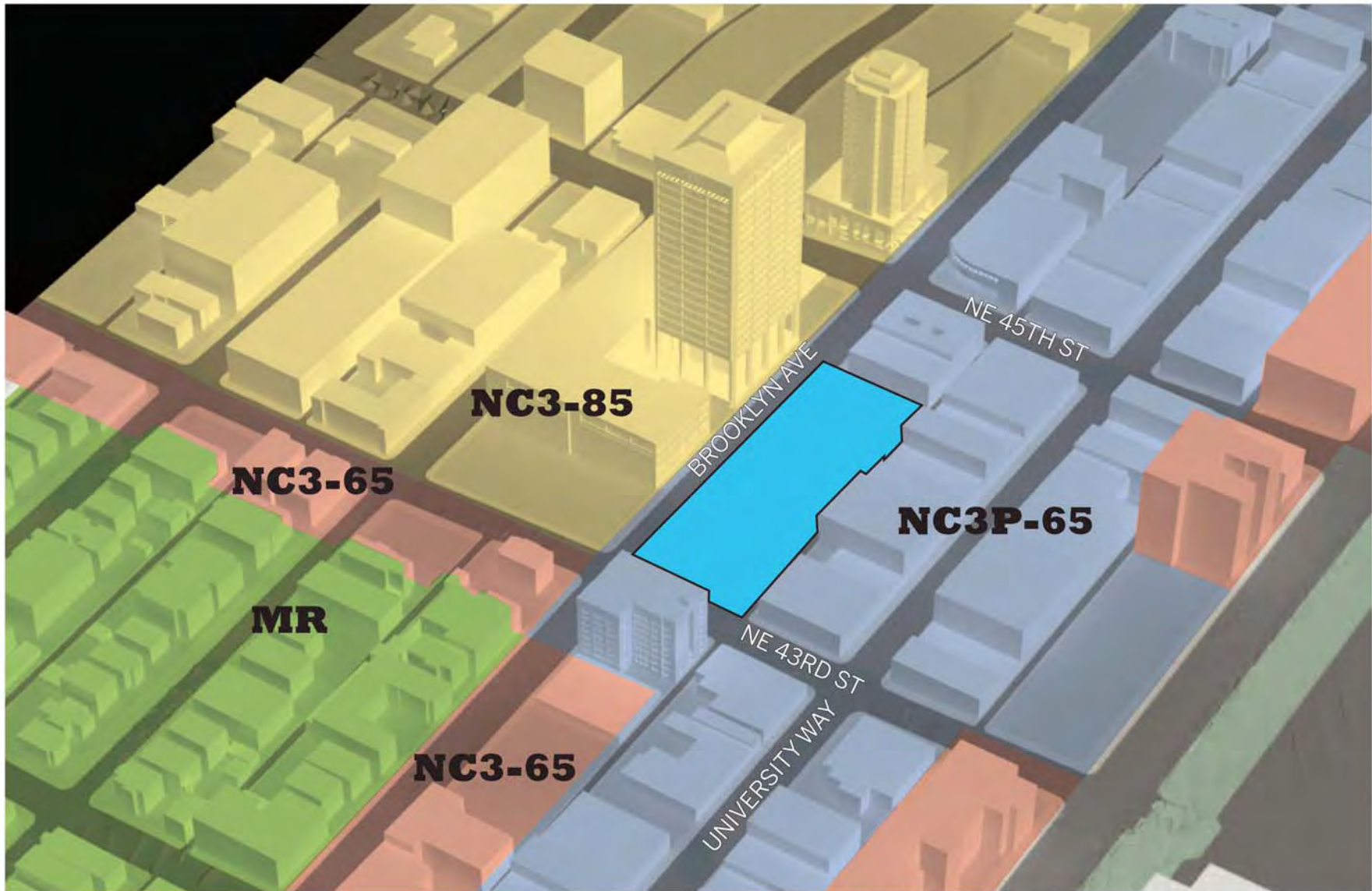
