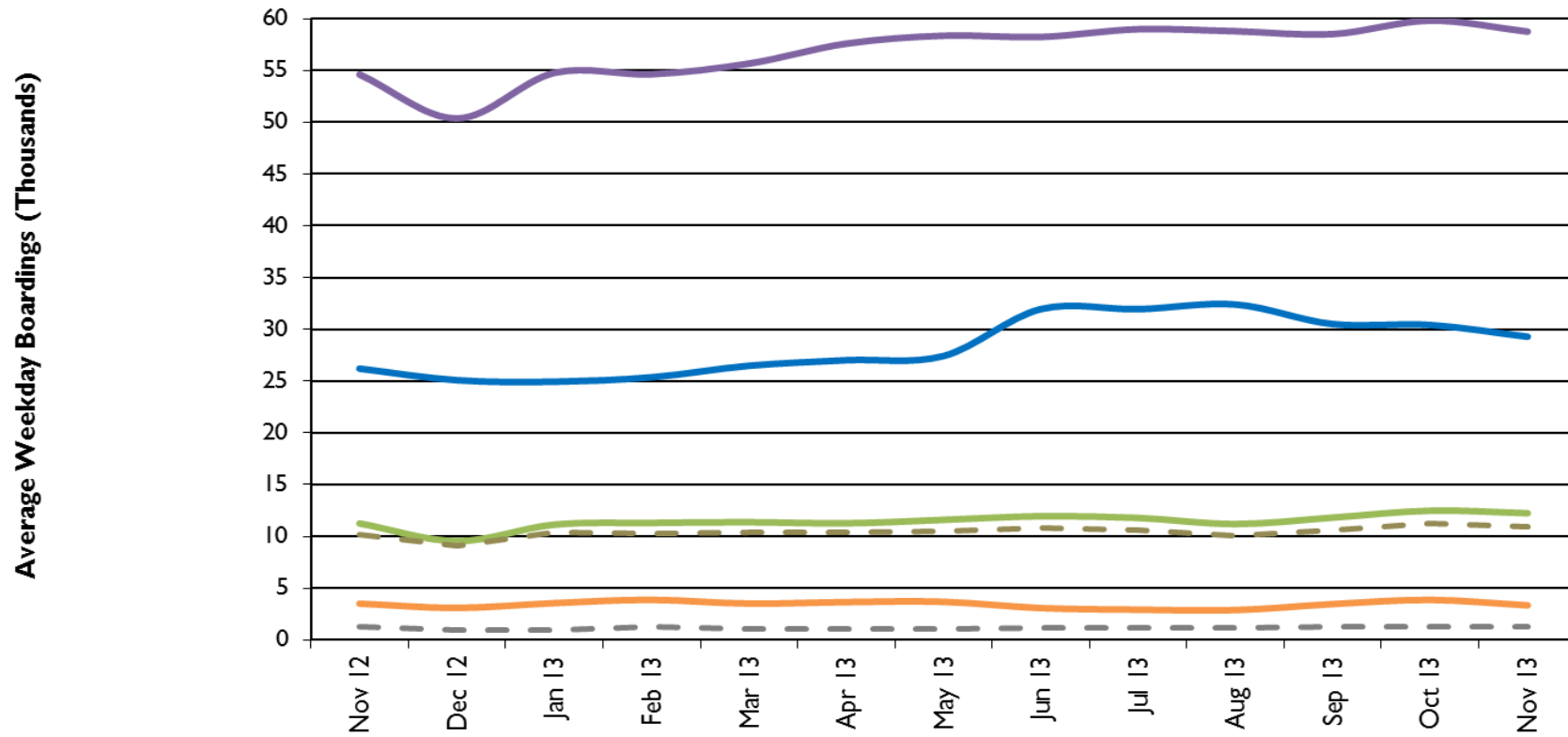
Sound Transit ridership increased by almost 5% in November 2013, led by strong growth in Central Link and ST Express boardings. Souder, Tacoma Link and Paratransit experienced declines compared with November 2012. ST Express routes in East King County, South King County and Pierce County saw the highest growth in bus ridership. Souder boarding totals were down slightly, but this was due to having one less weekday in November 2013 compared with November 2012; Souder weekday boardings were up over 8%, with a 1% increase on the North Line and an 8% increase on the South Line. Tacoma Link boardings continued a downward slide that began in August. Finally, paratransit boardings were down just under 2% for the month. No major service disruptions occurred during November.
