Ridership Analysis

January 2013: 22 weekdays, 4 Saturdays, 5 Sundays (2012: 21 weekdays, 4 Saturdays, 6 Sundays)

For January 2013, there was one additional weekday compared with the same month in 2012, which tended to increase total monthly ridership. In addition, January 2012 had a week of snow and ice weather which affected ridership last year. ST Express ridership continued a strong upward trend partly because all downtown Seattle boardings are now included in the totals; prior to elimination of the downtown Seattle Ride Free Area Sept. 29, free boardings were not included. Total Sounder boardings were up 27% in spite of numerous North Line slide disruptions in early January. The slide disruptions caused North Line boardings to decline by 28% compared with January 2012; by contrast, South Line ridership was up 35%, partially due to the Lakewood extension that opened in October and inclement weather in January 2012. Because the South Line typically represents about 90% of total Sounder ridership, the South Line increase offset declines on the North Line.
