### Report Fraud and Abuse in the DBE Program

Sound Transit has established a Fraud and Abuse Hotline for contractors and concerned individuals to report suspected fraud or abuse in the Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (DBE) Program. Concerns that should be reported include, but are not limited to:

- Contract Fraud
- Unapproved substitutions of DBEs
- Failure to follow contract procedures concerning DBEs, including sharing of equipment and employees
