

# South 200th Link extension

South 200<sup>th</sup> Link Extension was constructed to extend Link light rail service from SeaTac airport station south to S. 200<sup>th</sup> St. in the city of SeaTac.

## **Mode:**

Light rail

## **Highlights:**

Start of service: September 2016

Length: 1.6 miles from Sea-Tac Airport to S. 200<sup>th</sup> St.

Projected ridership: 5,400 daily boardings by 2018

Budget: \$383 million

Funding partners: FTA, TIGER III grant funding, PSRC, WSDOT

Planning partners: City of SeaTac and Port of Seattle

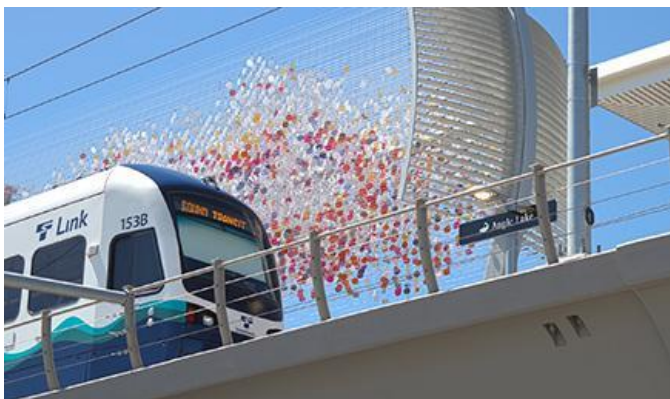
