



Boeing Access Road Station Project

Summer 2026

About the project

Sound Transit's Boeing Access Road Station project would add a new station to the existing 1 Line of the Link light rail network along the west side of East Marginal Way South, just north of South 112th Street in Tukwila. The station was part of the 1996 Sound Move Plan and the voter-approved Sound Transit 3 (ST3) system plan in 2016 to enhance connectivity and accessibility in our region.

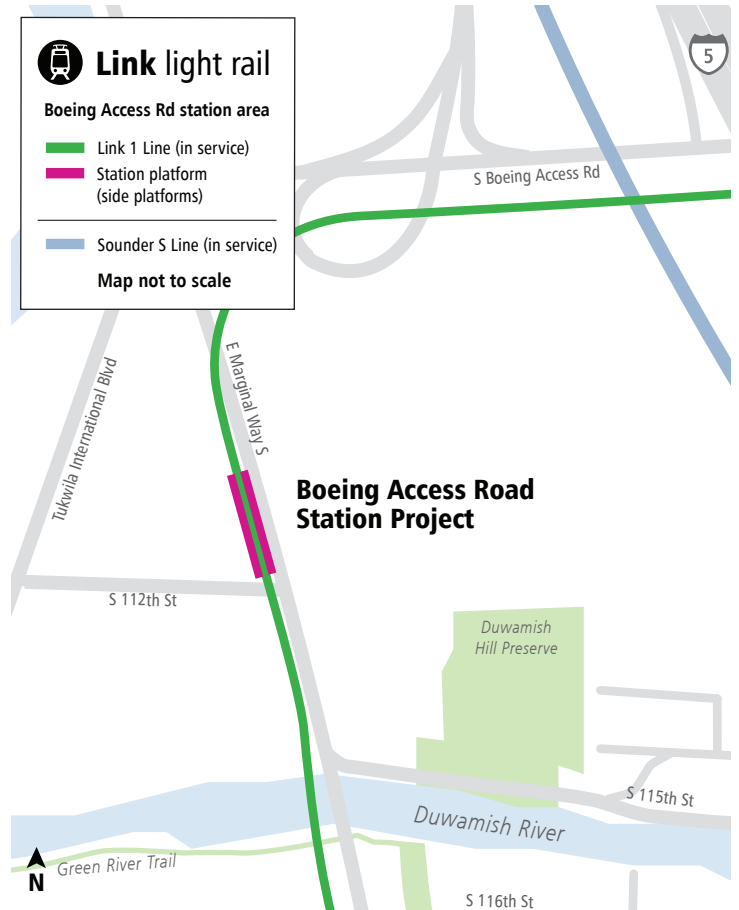
Project benefits and elements

Adding a new station at Boeing Access Road would:

- **Bridge the 5.5-mile gap between the Rainier Beach and Tukwila International Boulevard stations**, expanding access to high-capacity transit in the region.
- **Increase access to the larger Link light rail network** to help people get to the places they need to go daily.
- **Provide connections to Link light rail** by including a new parking facility and a bus transfer facility.
- **Accommodate future growth** and planned transportation improvements in the project area.

Equity and inclusion

At Sound Transit, we are committed to creating the conditions necessary to achieve racial equity within our agency and the broader community. We are challenging ourselves to plan, build, and operate public transit that provides equitable access to housing, education, medical facilities, and job opportunities, especially for those most harmed by institutional and systemic racism.

Summer 2026 update

In May 2026, the Sound Transit Board adopted an updated ST3 System Plan to guide the next phase of transit expansion projects across the region. This action established a sustainable path forward to address an estimated \$34.5 billion gap in the agency's financial plan over the next 20 years and deliver the voter-approved ST3 program.

Under the updated System Plan adopted by the Board, the Boeing Access Road Station project is continuing to move forward. The Board's commitment to completing environmental review and design for the full project will allow the agency to continue to refine the project, identify opportunities to reduce costs, and pursue additional funding and financing tools. Importantly, it maintains momentum on the project and provides the runway to secure additional funding and unlock cost savings that will deliver light rail at Boeing Access Road.

While construction of Boeing Access Road Station is not currently affordable, Sound Transit will develop a plan for identifying cost savings and alternative financing and delivery options for the Boeing Access Road Station in collaboration with the City of Tukwila and King County. This plan is expected to be submitted to the Board as soon as February 2027.

Community engagement

The next major milestone will be the completion of preliminary engineering and environmental documentation, which is anticipated to be available to the public in 2027.

Following this, the project will complete the Planning phase and move into the Design phase.

Along with technical considerations, community feedback will inform the station design and associated elements. We are coordinating with the City of Tukwila, community organizations, and individuals to host briefings, open houses, and additional outreach and engagement.

Community engagement and input help Sound Transit plan and design a system that reflects your community's needs and desires. There will be several opportunities to engage throughout the project, and you can reach out with questions, thoughts, or a request for a briefing for your community.
