

- 3.4 miles, 2 stations
 - Marymoor Village Station
 - Downtown Redmond Station
- 1,400 stall parking garage at Marymoor Village with Ground floor transit center
- Design Build Delivery 1 Contract
- Start of service: 2024
- Redmond to Bellevue Downtown: 17 minutes
- Redmond to Downtown Seattle: 42 minutes
- Four-minute headways during peak hours

Recovery and impact from Teamsters Strike, COVID-19, supply-chain interruptions, inflation, and labor availability.






The Issue:
