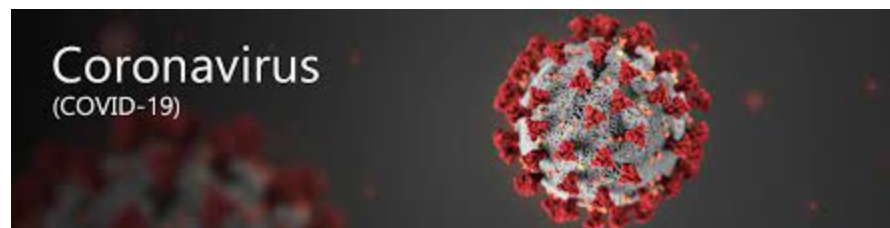

Response

- Began monitoring in late December 2019
- Update to agency Contagious Virus Response Plan
- Participation in Agency Coronavirus Team
- Consolidated Hygiene Supply Ordering Process
- SME insight for agency response/documentation



Continuity of Operations

Continuity of Operational Plan (COOP)

- Annual COOP review initiated in January 2020
- Coordination with internal partners during pandemic response
- Current review ongoing



Next Steps

Ongoing and expansion work efforts

- Support of expansion efforts – NGL, TDLE, ELE, DRLE, LLE
FLS, Training, Familiarization, Drills
- Scheduled annual review of EM documents
EMP January 2022, COOP March 2022
- Engage Snohomish County for development of HIRA – 2022
