

I-90 Two Way Transit and HOV Operations Stage 1

The I-90 Two-Way Transit & HOV Operations project improves regional mobility by providing safe and reliable two-way transit on I-90 between Bellevue and Seattle. The project built full-time HOV lanes for eastbound and westbound traffic on the outer I-90 roadways and will retain the existing reversible lane operations in the center roadway.

The project is being implemented in stages. Each stage of the project provides viable and independent transit and transportation benefits that can be funded and constructed as financing becomes available. Three stages have been identified for the project.
