

Kirkland Transit Center

The Kirkland Transit Center project improved the new transit center on 3rd Street between Central Way and Kirkland Avenue. The project transformed the existing 22-year-old facility by adding new waiting areas, passenger shelters, an enhanced pedestrian crossing and improved the speed and reliability of bus service. A new traffic signal, intersection and traffic circulation improvements smooth traffic flow around the transit center and enhance pedestrian safety for transit customers and residents. Bicycle amenities, landscaping and public art were also part of the project.
