

Lynnwood HOV Access/46th Ave W

The Lynnwood HOV Access project provides direct access ramps connecting the new Lynnwood Transit Center with the north and southbound HOV lanes on I-5. The ramps provide safer, faster and more convenient travel for general HOV traffic and buses. The Lynnwood Transit Center is the hub of Community Transit's local transit service for south Snohomish County. Community Transit and Sound Transit also provide commuter express transit service from this site.
