

Mountlake Terrace Freeway Station

The Mountlake Terrace Freeway Station project built a freeway station in the I-5 median at 236th Street Southwest. The project includes a pedestrian bridge that connects the station to the Mountlake Terrace Transit Center. The work increased bus speed and schedule reliability while maintaining convenient customer access. The freeway station allows ST Express buses to provide service to Community Transit's new transit center and parking structure via the pedestrian bridge.
