

M Street to Lakewood Track and Signal

The M Street to Lakewood track and signal project upgraded seven miles of existing track and street crossings in the Lakeview Subdivision rail corridor from South M Street in Tacoma to Bridgeport Way Southwest in Lakewood. The project was part of the Sounder commuter rail extension of service from Tacoma to Lakewood.

This project provided all new track and signal systems and street crossing improvements at 13 at-grade railroad crossings.
