

# Newcastle Transit Improvements

The Newcastle transit improvements project provides new bus shelters, traffic improvements and bicycle/pedestrian access enhancements in the area around the intersection of Newcastle Way and Coal Creek Parkway.

The work included building four new bus shelters and providing space for additional bus shelters in the future. Intersection improvements included new street channelization and signal system upgrades enhance transit speed and schedule reliability and benefit general traffic circulation. New bicycle lanes, pedestrian islands and sidewalks increased safety and improved access to transit for bicycle riders and pedestrians.
