

Redmond Transit Center

The Redmond Transit Center provides transportation infrastructure that serves downtown Redmond and was built at the site of an existing bus transfer facility. The new transit center improves passenger loading, provides six new bus bays, includes weather protected passenger shelters, improves pedestrian crossings and added bus layover capacity. The project also completed street improvements nearby and created a pedestrian-friendly environment.
