

# Redmond Way Improvements

The Redmond Way improvements project was designed to improve transit reliability and pedestrian connections to transit.

The project constructed a center median on Redmond Way, extended the westbound right-hand turn lane at 132nd Avenue Northeast, provided a sidewalk and planter strip along the north side of Northeast Redmond Way and improved intersections at 132nd Avenue Northeast and 140th Avenue Northeast.
