

Woodinville Arterial HOV Enhancements

This project increased bus speed and reliability and enhanced ridership in the Woodinville and Bothell area. The project provides a flyer stop on the SR-522 eastbound off-ramp at SR-202 and added transit-only lanes on the SR-522 off-ramps.

Sound Transit buses serve the new flyer stop and existing companion stop on the westbound on-ramp. The new flyer stops allow Sound Transit buses to exit and enter SR-522 without traveling through the local arterial system.
