

6 options to be evaluated




Option 1: C9T Main Street Portal



Center Running to Main Street

- At grade crossing from east to center south of 15th
- 112th Ave widened east to create space for light rail median
- At grade crossing of SB 112th Ave at Main St


Option 2: C9T Main Street Portal



Side Running to Main Street

- East side south of SE 6th St
- At-grade crossing of 112th Ave at SE 6th St
- West side north of SE 6th St

Option 3: C9T 2nd Street Portal



Center Running to 2nd Street

- Crosses under northbound lanes to enter center of 112th Ave
- 112th Ave widened east to create space for light rail median
- At grade crossing of SB 112th Ave at 2nd St

Option 4: C9T 2nd Street Portal



East Side Running to 2nd Street

- At-grade south of SE 8th St
- Depressed in a retained cut north of SE 8th St

Option 5: C11A 108th At Grade

Center Running to At Grade


- Crosses to center under 112th Ave at Y
- 112th Ave widened east to create light rail median
- Elevated center running from Hilton Hotel to Main St



Option 6: C11A 108th At Grade

Center and West Side Running

- At grade crossing from east to center south of 15th St
- 112th Ave widened to east to create a light rail median south of SE 6th St
- Crosses from center to west at SE 6th St



Hospital Station Location Alternatives

- **Station serves Hospital District and Wilberton area**
- **~2,500' from 120th Station if located at NE 8th St**



- **Children's Hospital closest to 120th Station**



Option A: North of NE 8th



Option B: Span NE 8th



Option C: South of NE 10th



Option D: North of NE 10th
