



POTENTIAL STATION LOCATIONS



The voter-approved ST 2 Plan included stations at Kent/Des Moines and S. 272nd. 


Sound Transit is evaluating alternatives to extend Link light rail 7.6 miles from the future Angle Lake light rail station on South 200th Street in SeaTac to the Federal Way Transit Center.


Currently, project funding is available for construction to Kent/Des Moines. Sound Transit is working to establish a shovel-ready plan to extend service from Kent/Des Moines to the Federal Way Transit Center in the event additional funding is secured.

Sound Transit has conducted the first phases of the project development process, which evaluated potential alternatives to extend light rail in the project corridor. In the next phase, Sound Transit will prepare a Draft Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) that evaluates potential environmental impacts and benefits of the alternatives identified. The Draft EIS is expected to be available for public and agency review in late 2014.

DRAFT EIS TO STUDY FOUR POTENTIAL ALTERNATIVES

In September 2013, the Sound Transit Board identified four alternatives for further evaluation in the Draft EIS:

SR 99 alternative would extend south from Angle Lake Station to follow the SR 99 median. This alternative includes four design options.

Interstate 5 alternative would extend south from Angle Lake Station to follow the west side of I-5. This alternative includes a design option.

SR 99/I-5 alternative would extend south from Angle Lake Station to follow the SR 99 median to about Kent-Des Moines Road, where it would then transition to the east and follow the I-5 alignment to Federal Way.

I-5/SR 99 alternative Identical to the I-5 alternative, it would extend south from Angle Lake Station to follow the west side of I-5 to about Kent-Des Moines Road, where it would then transition to the west and follow the SR 99 alignment to Federal Way.
