Light rail and bus rapid transit are two examples of high capacity transit (HCT)



Example: Existing Tacoma Link

Light rail is an electric railway powered by an overhead power source. It is versatile and flexible, and can run at street level, in tunnels or on elevated right-of-way. Light rail is flexible to meet varying demand.



Example: King County Metro's RapidRide

Bus rapid transit can be a fast, high frequency, limited stop bus service that operates with some priority over other traffic. Stations are further apart than local service to achieve higher travel speeds.



Example: Pierce Transit bus
