

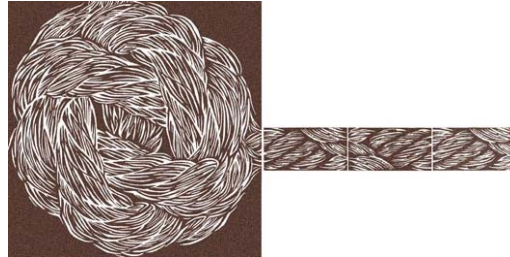

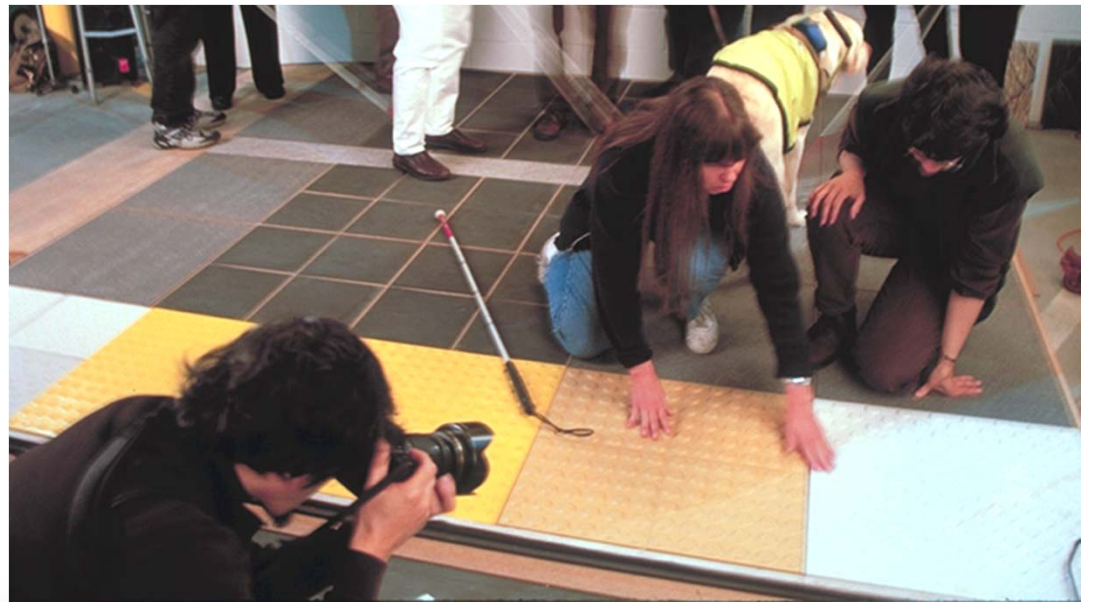

Types of Stations & Current Progress



- Brooklyn Station
 - 60% design – late Spring 2012
- Roosevelt Station
 - 60% design – early Spring 2012
- Northgate Station
 - 30% design – completed in November 2011
 - 60% design – mid-year 2012





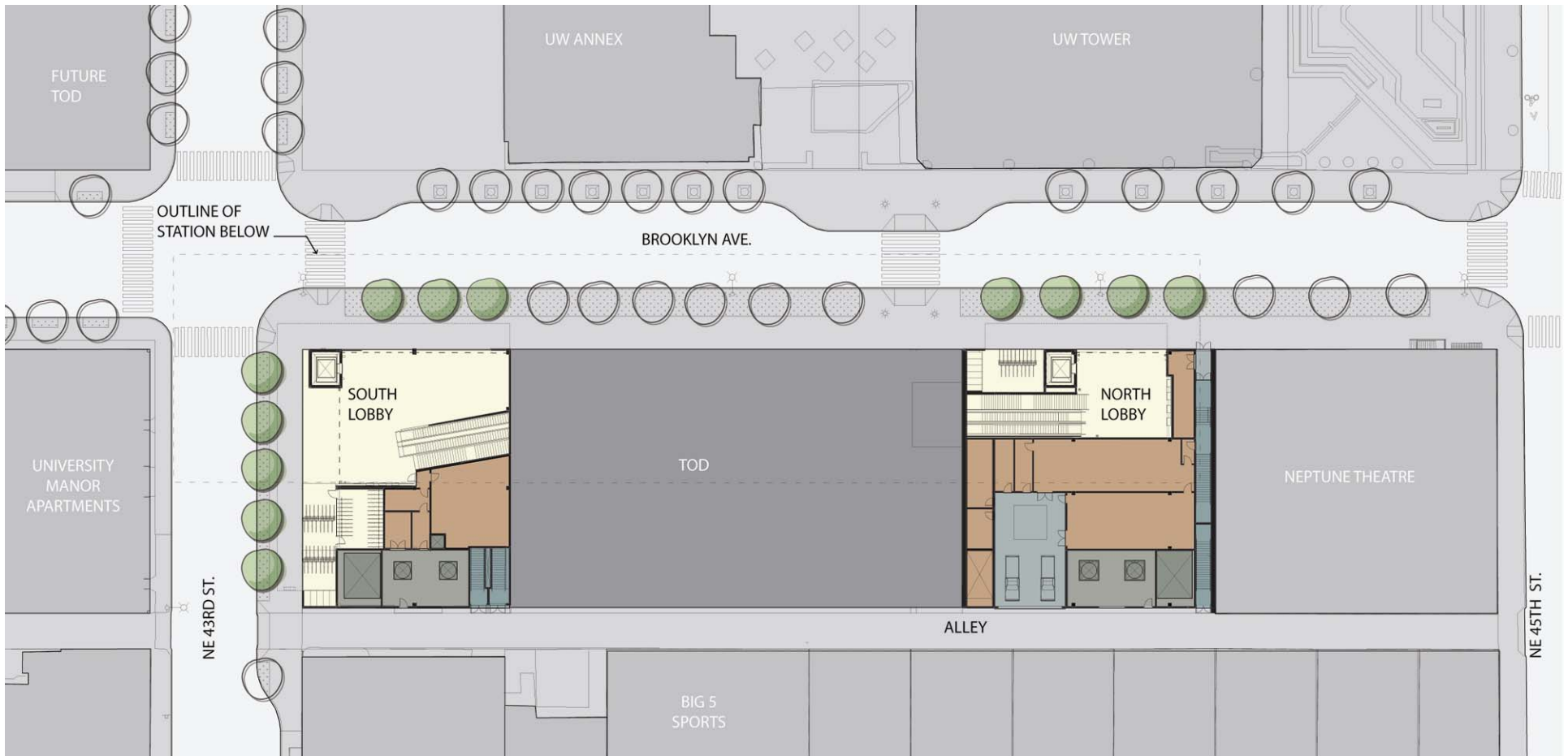
Brooklyn Station

Key Features:

- Underground station with two entrances
- 75' – 85' deep with escalators, elevators and stairs
- Bicycle parking
- 12,000 daily boardings (2030)
- TOD built over station

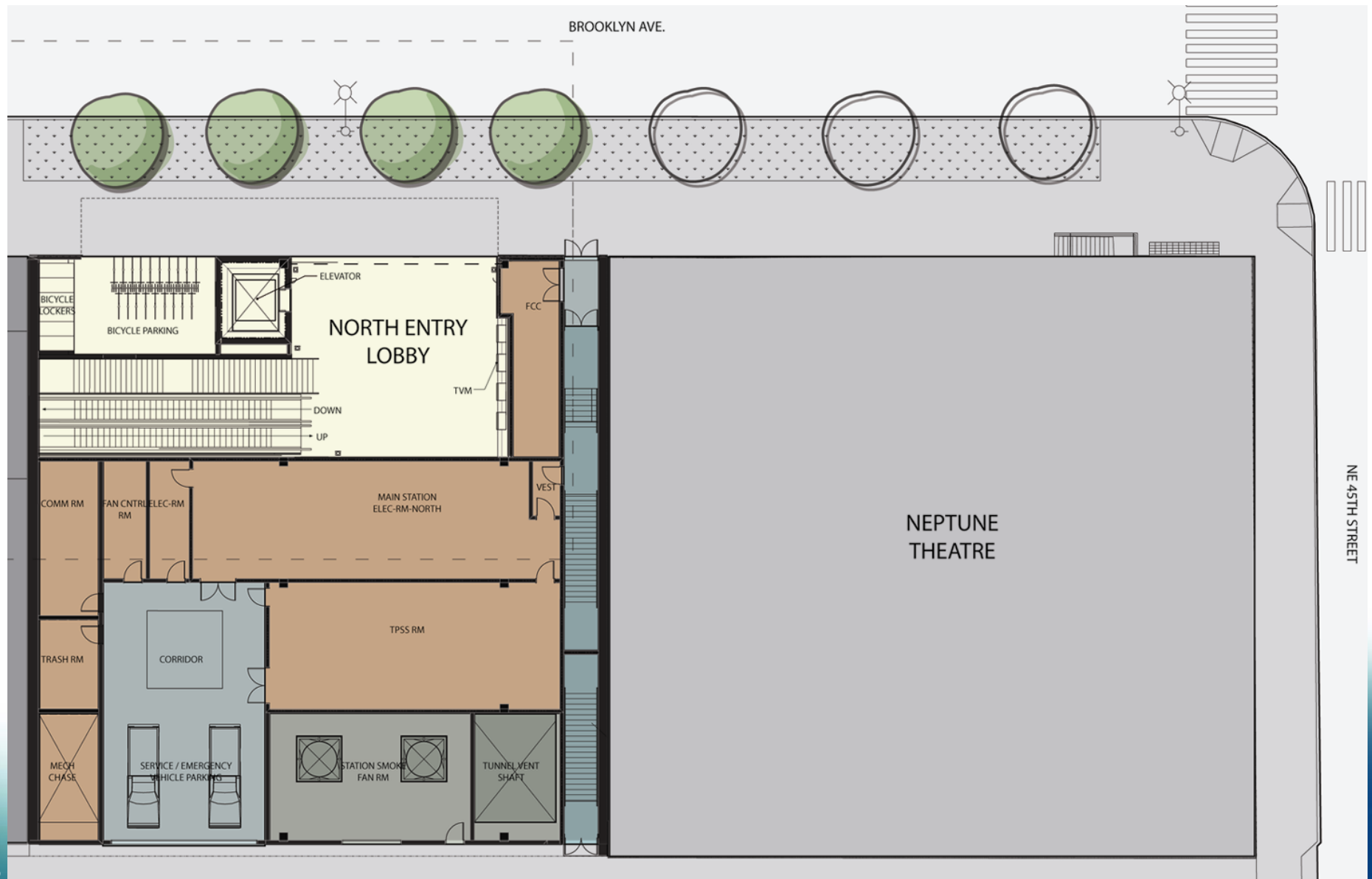

Grade Level Plan



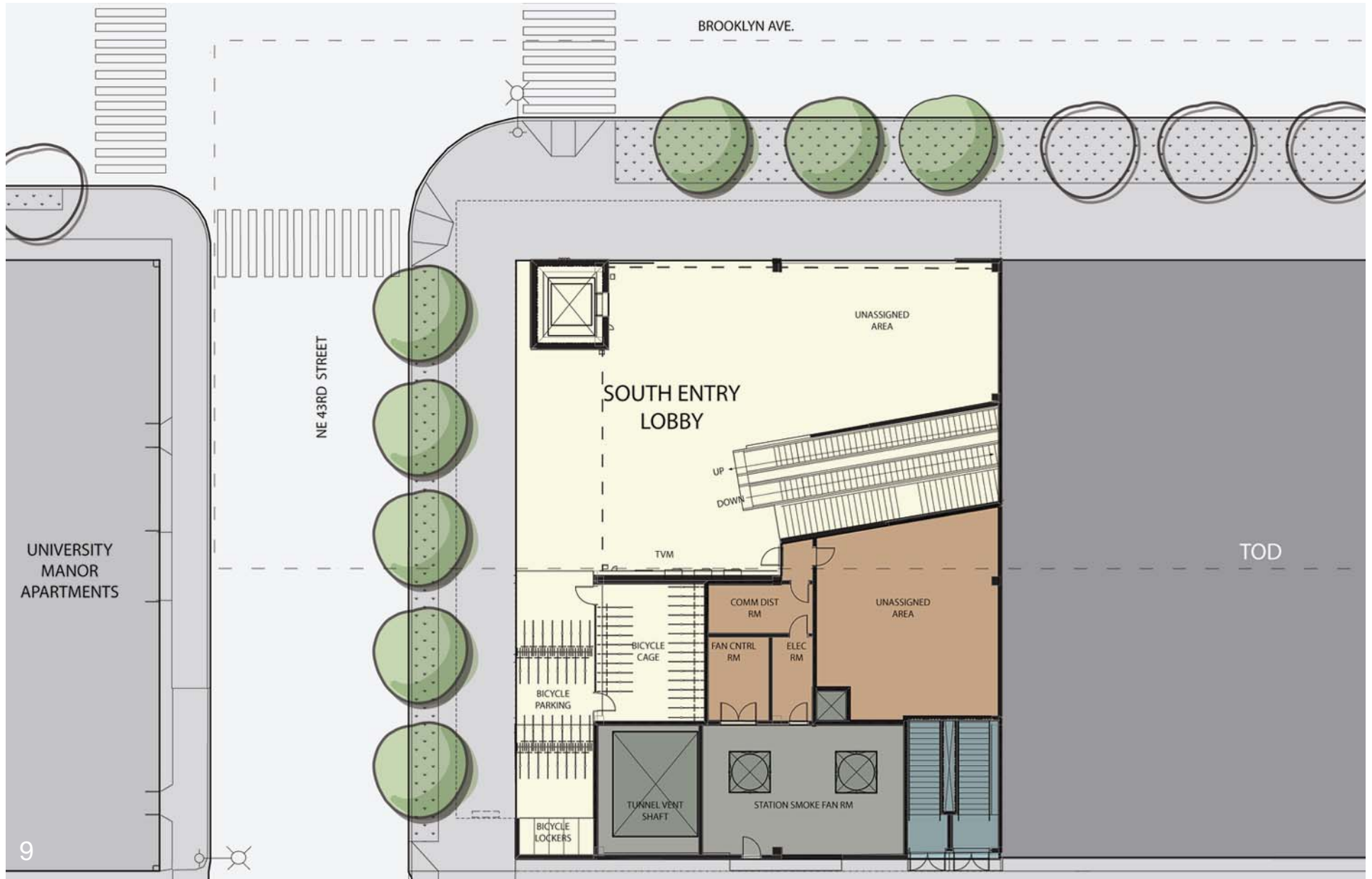

North Entrance Plan



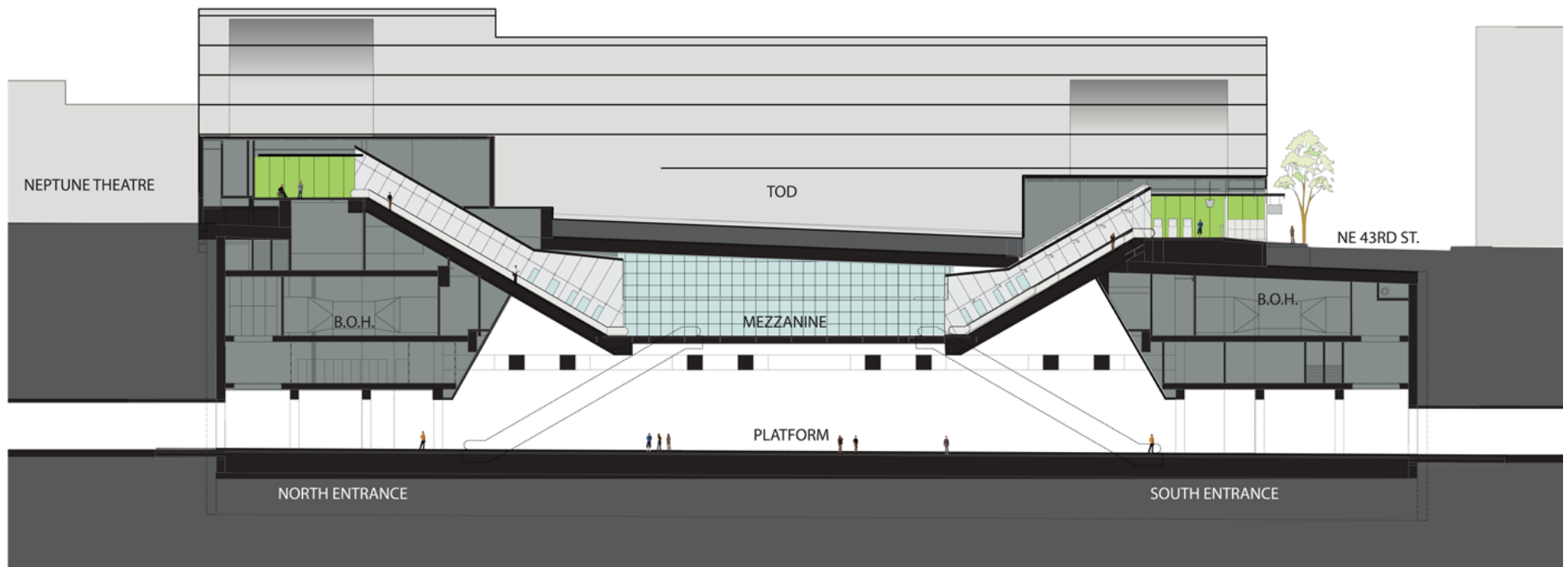

Key Features

- Station platform 70'-90' underground
- Elevators, escalators and stairs at both entrances
- Bicycle parking
- Connections to buses on NE 65th St, 12th Ave NE and Roosevelt Way NE
- 8,000 daily boardings (2030)



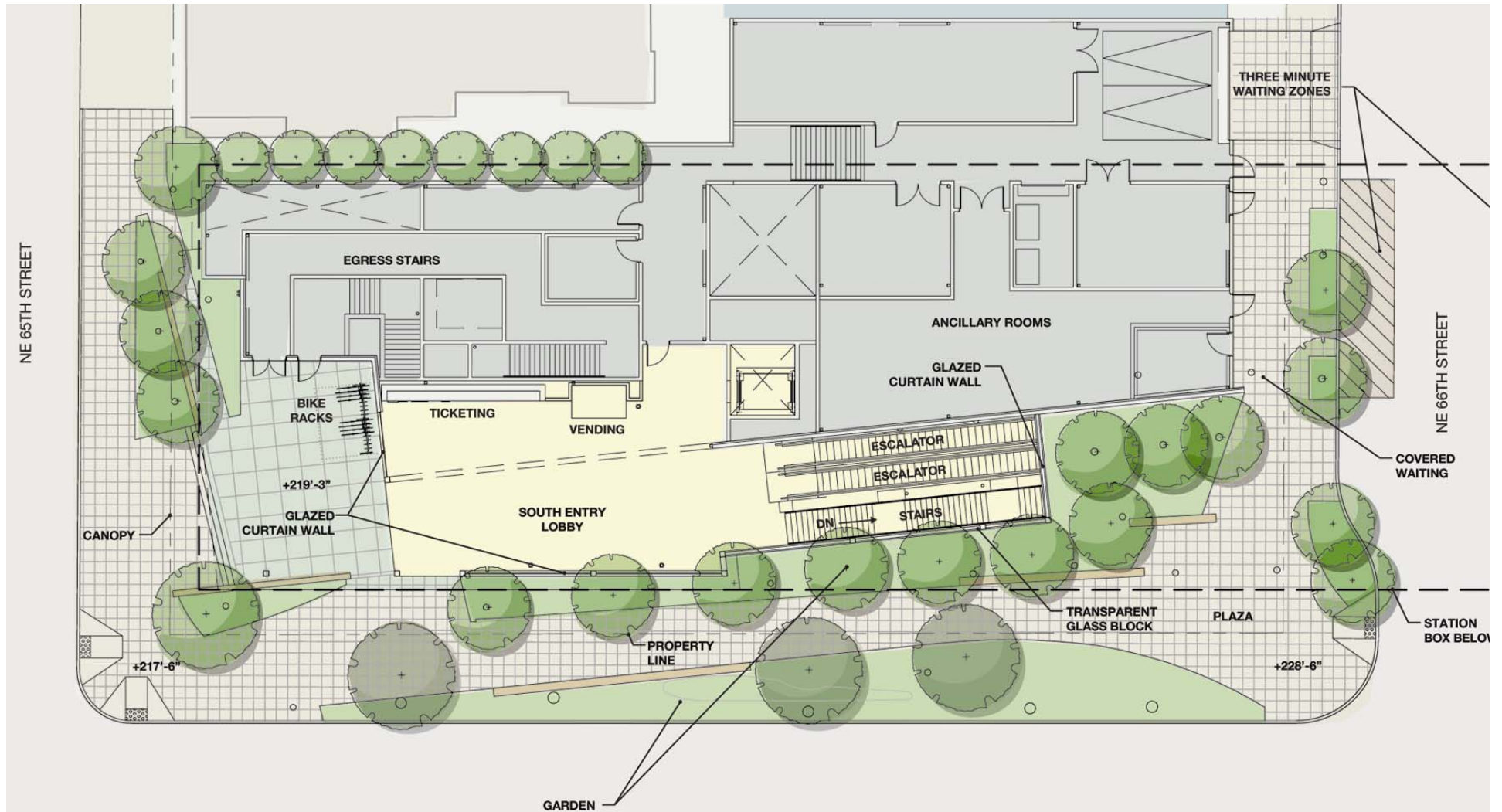

Grade Level Plan



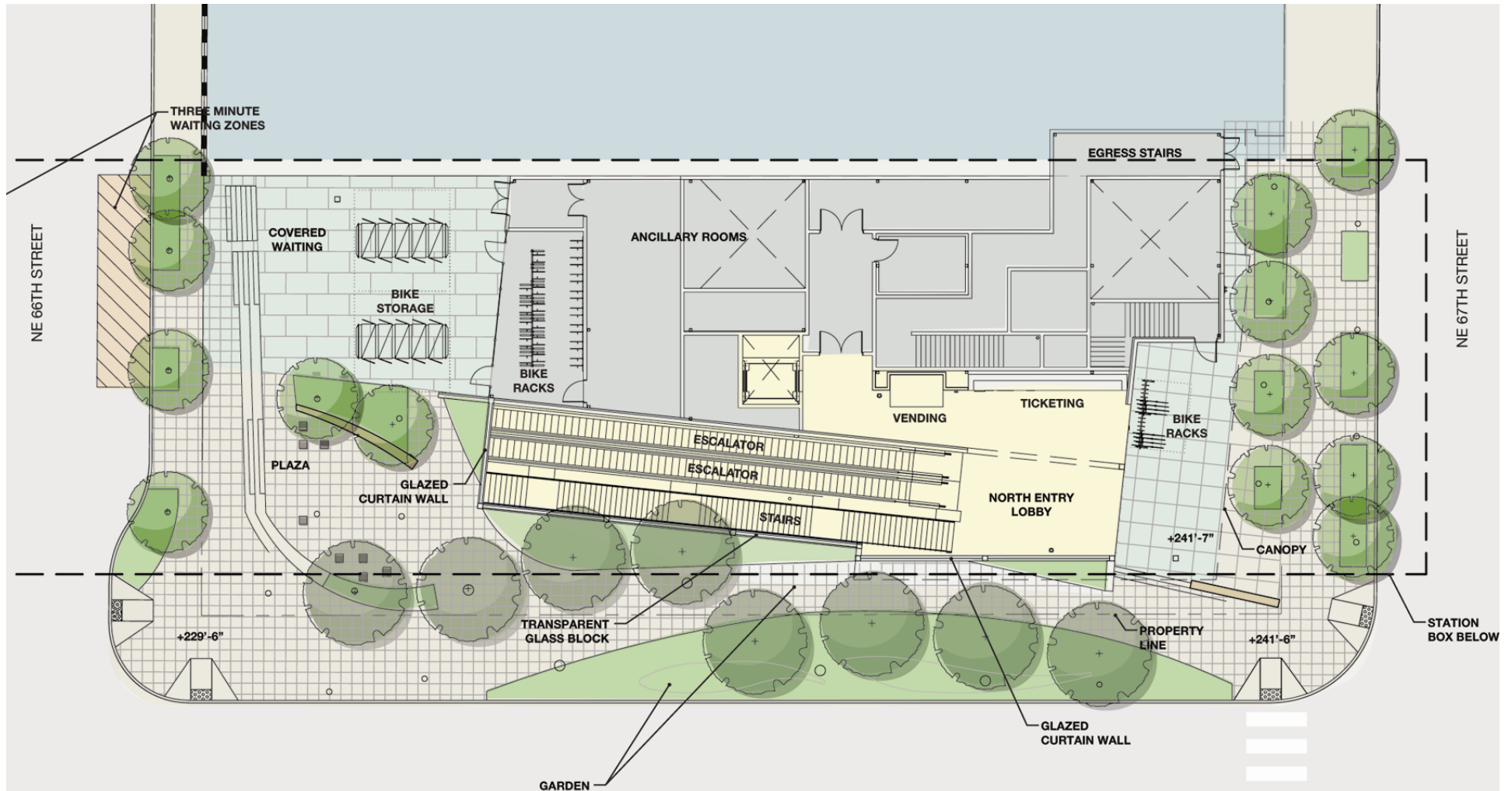

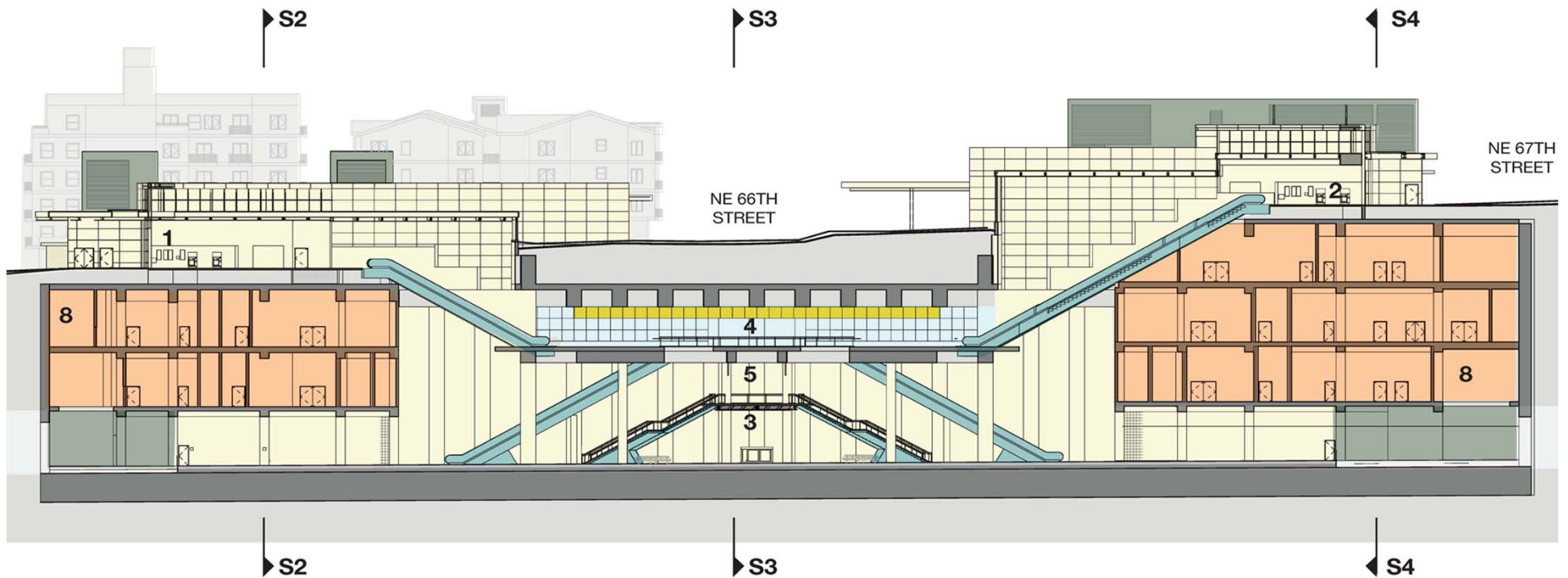

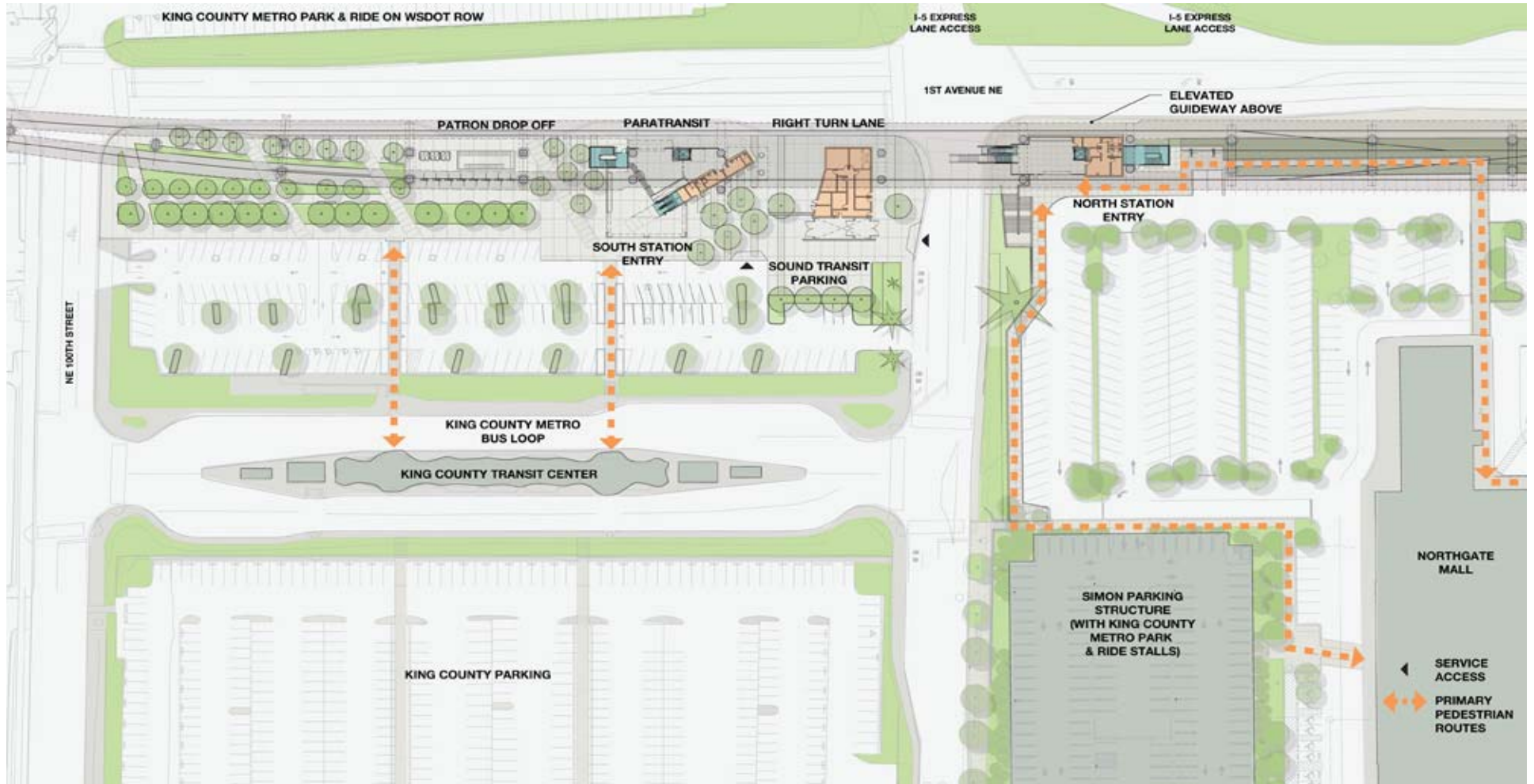
Key Features:

- 25' - 45' high with escalators, elevators and stairs
- North entrance connects Mall
- South entrance connects to buses and park-and ride lots
- Bicycle parking
- 15,000 daily boardings (2030)
- Inter-agency work team



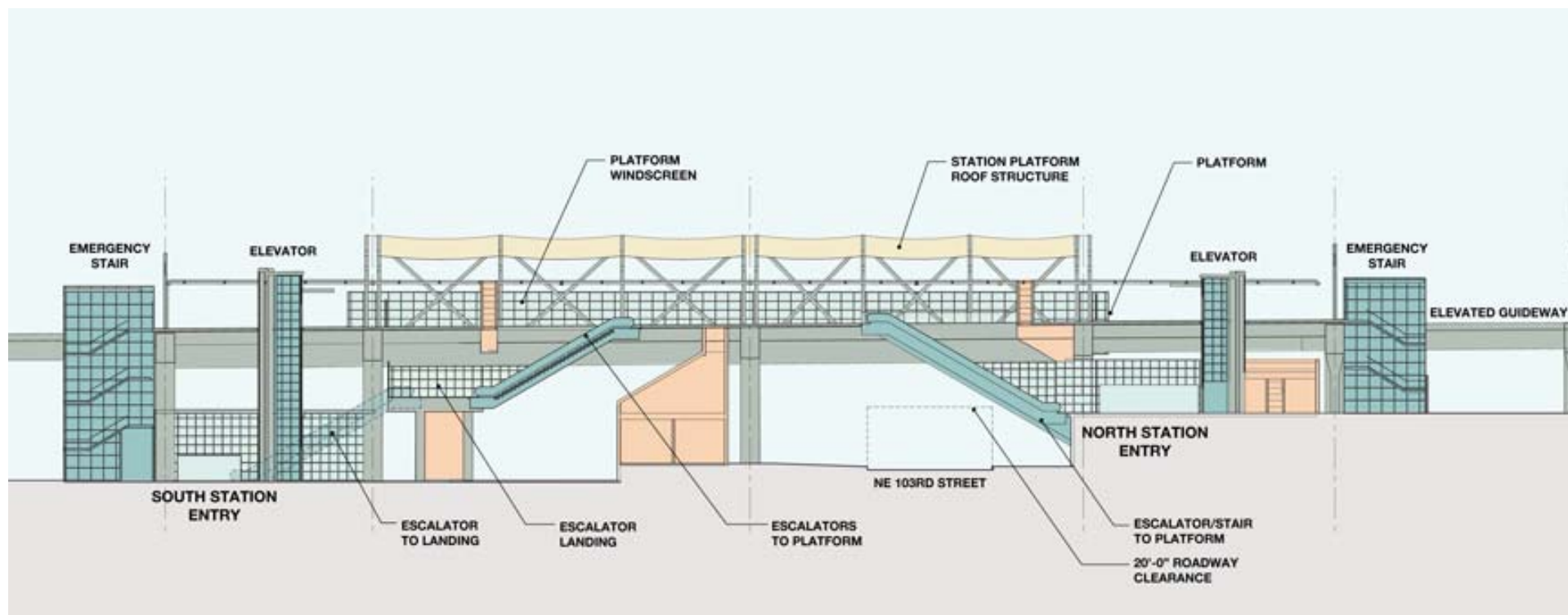

Station Area Connections



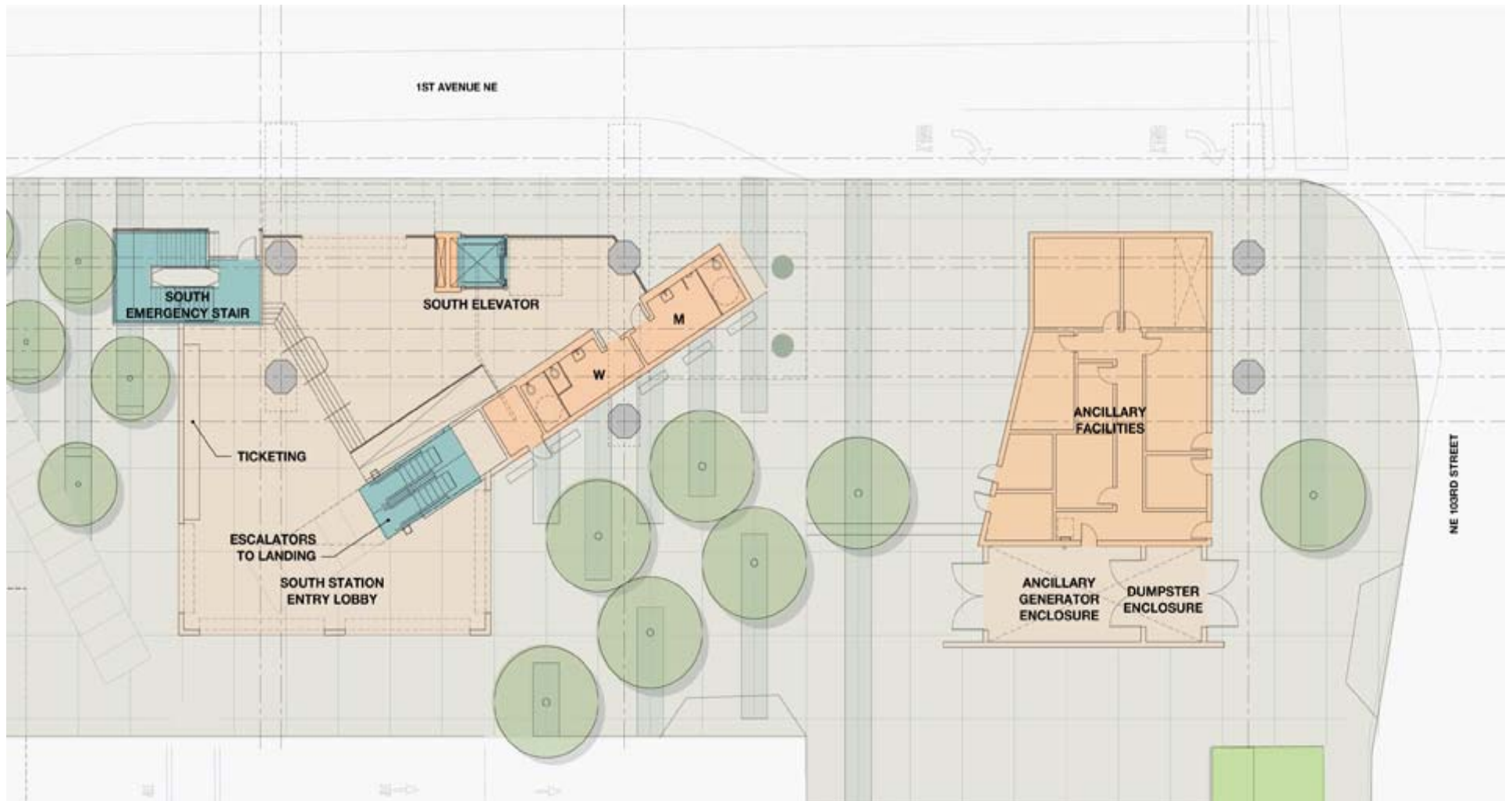

Station Section Plan



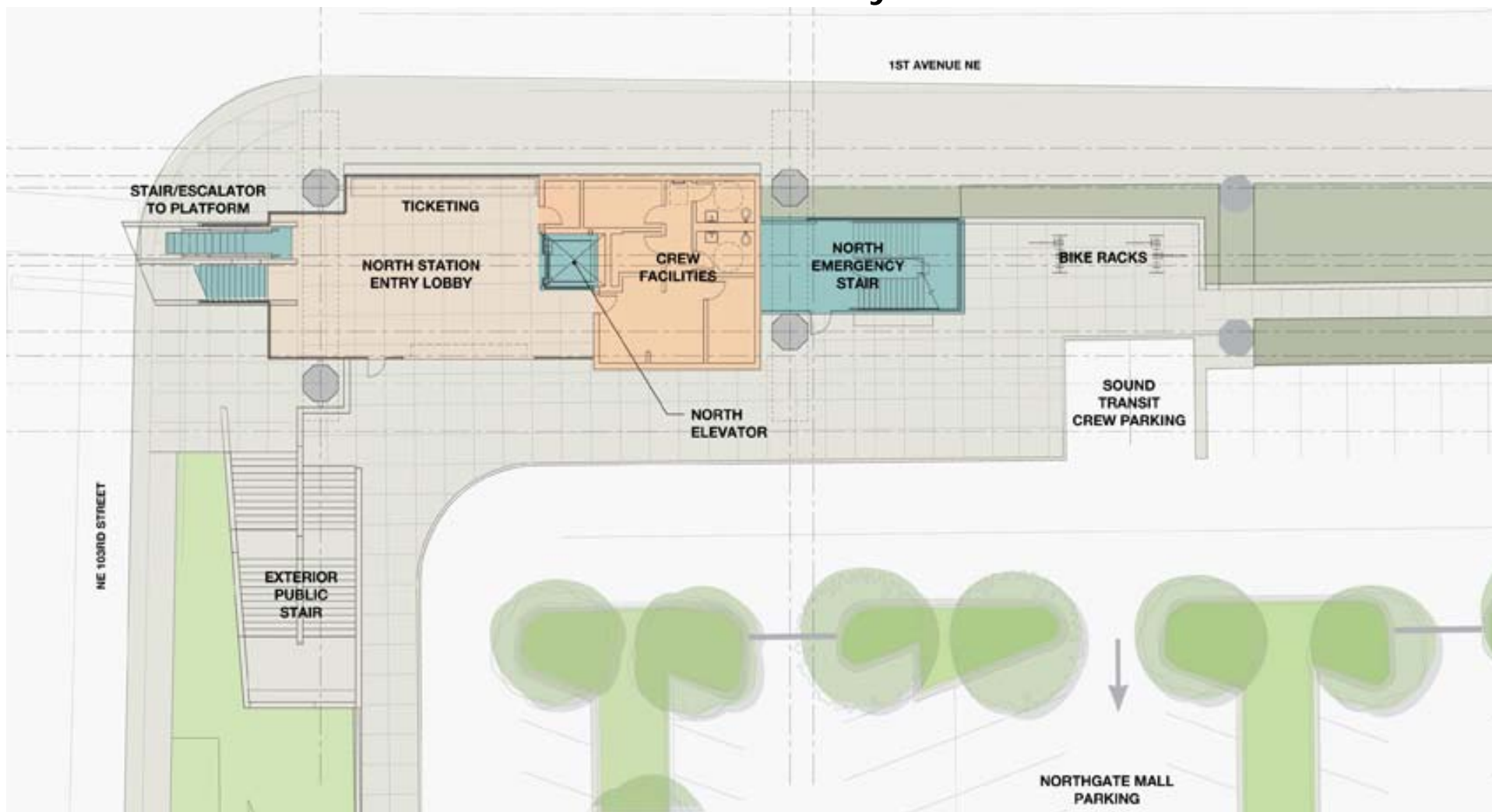

South Station Entry Plan



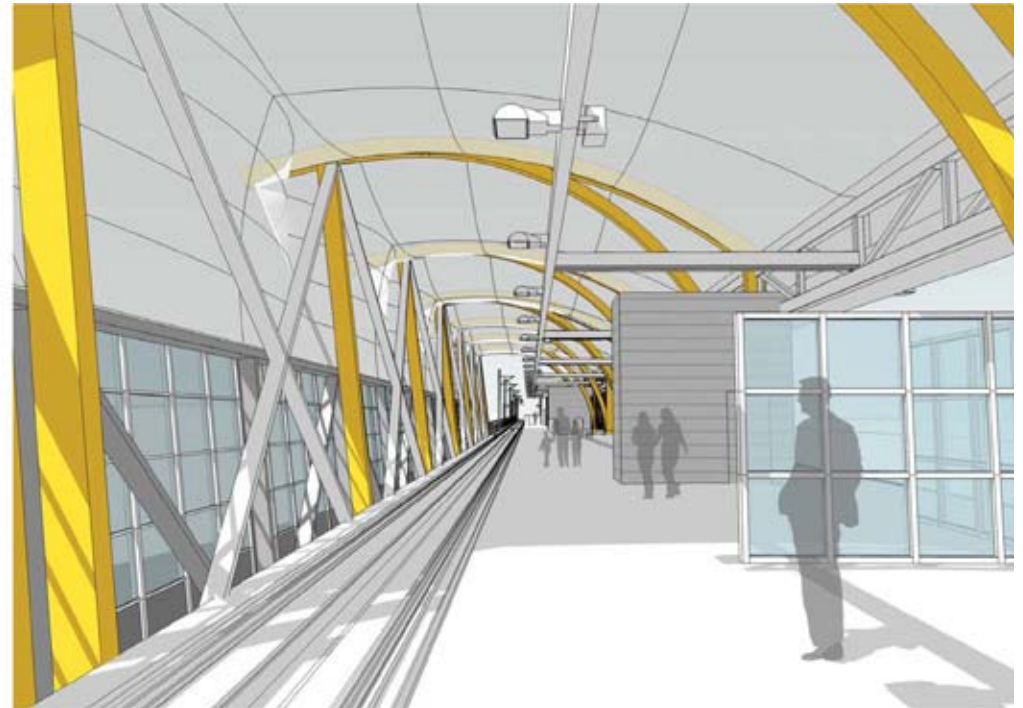
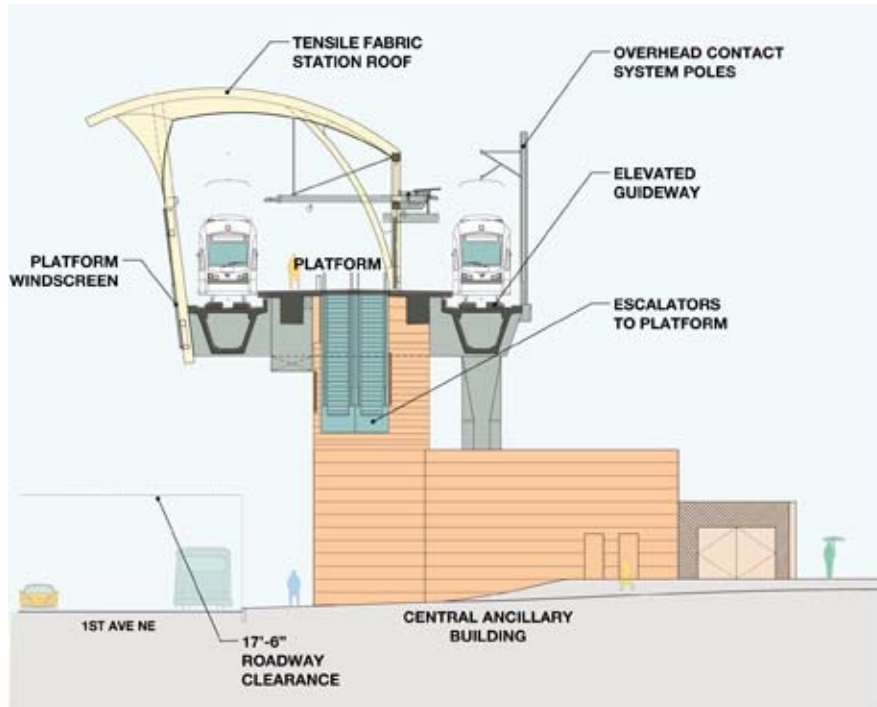

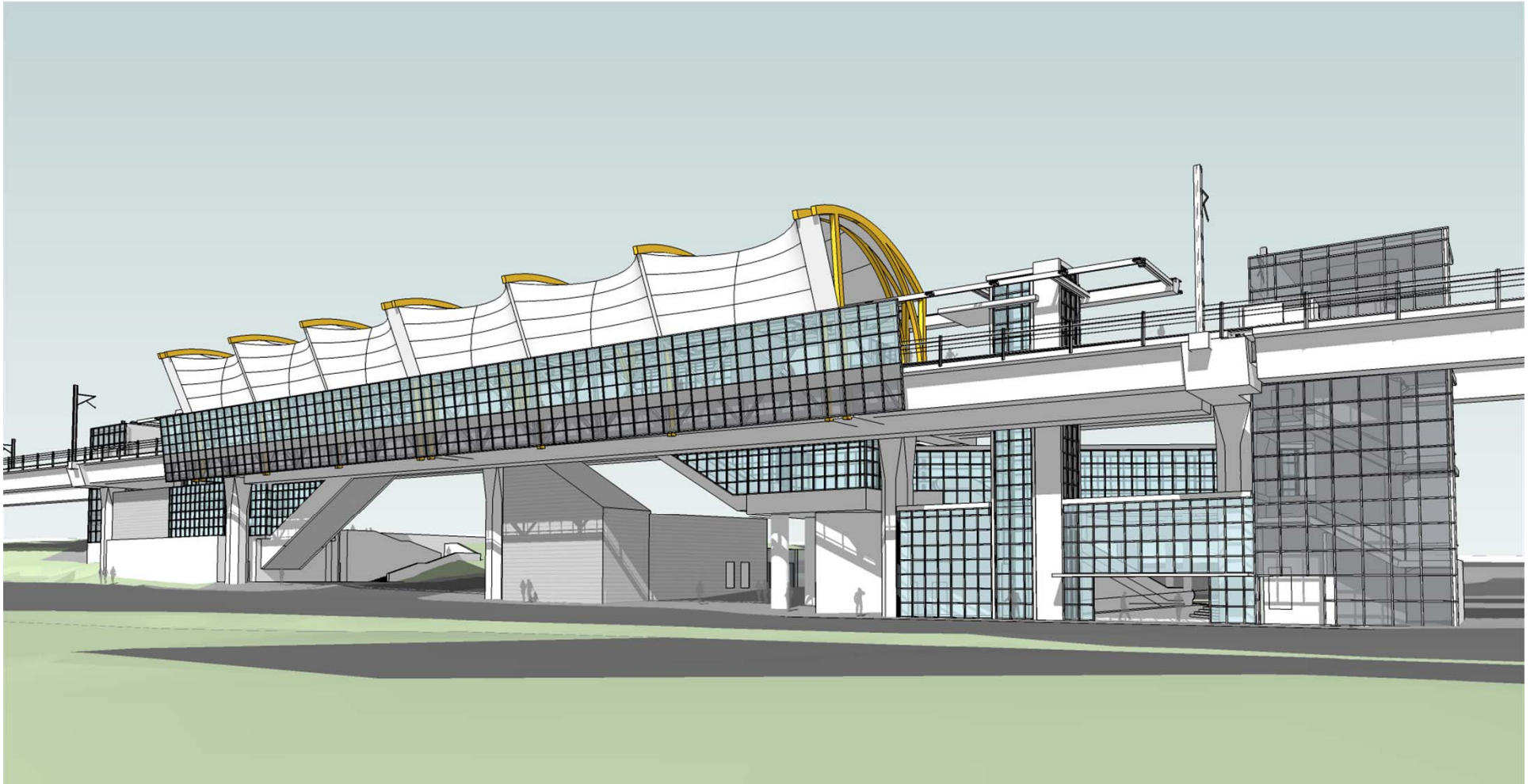
