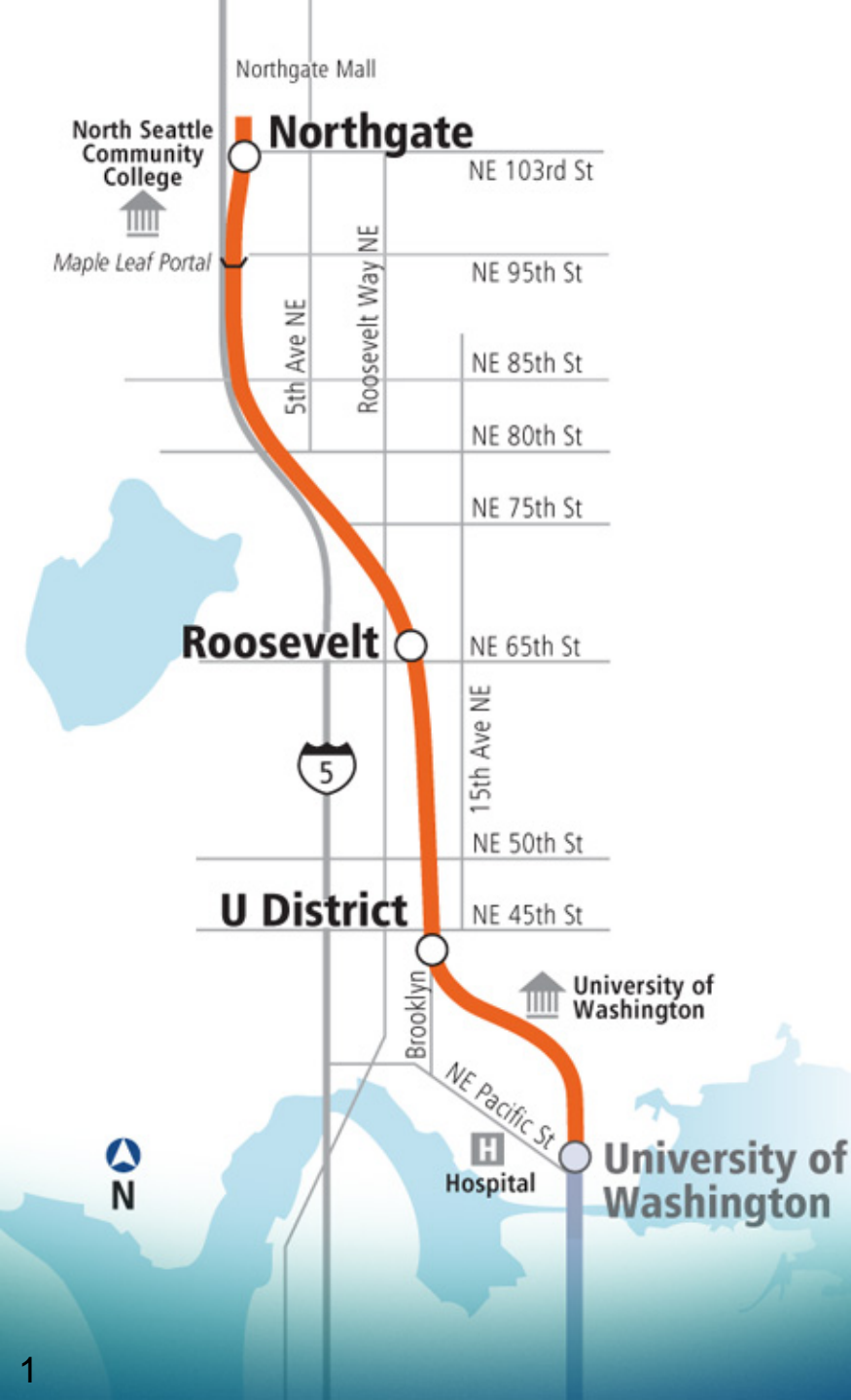

Roosevelt Station Construction Open House

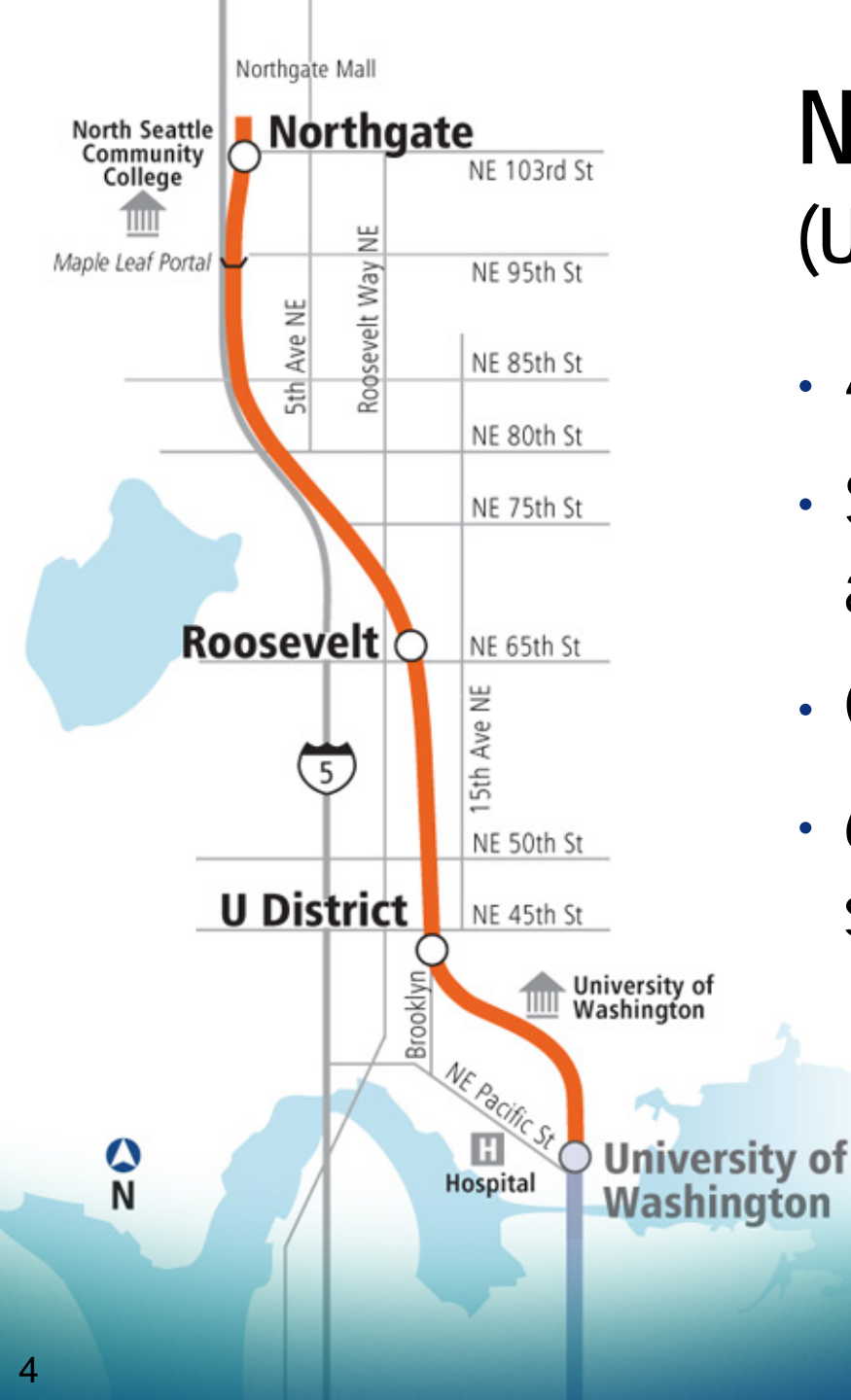
October 23, 2013



Link Light Rail System

- 16 miles of light rail with 13 stations currently in service
- University Link and Angle Lake Station under construction; open 2016
- ST2 Plan funded extensions to Overlake, South King County, and Lynnwood
- 54 mile system





Northgate Link

(University District to Northgate)

- 4.3-mile light rail extension
- Stations at U District, Roosevelt, and Northgate
- Completion: 2021
- 62,000 daily boardings added to system by 2030

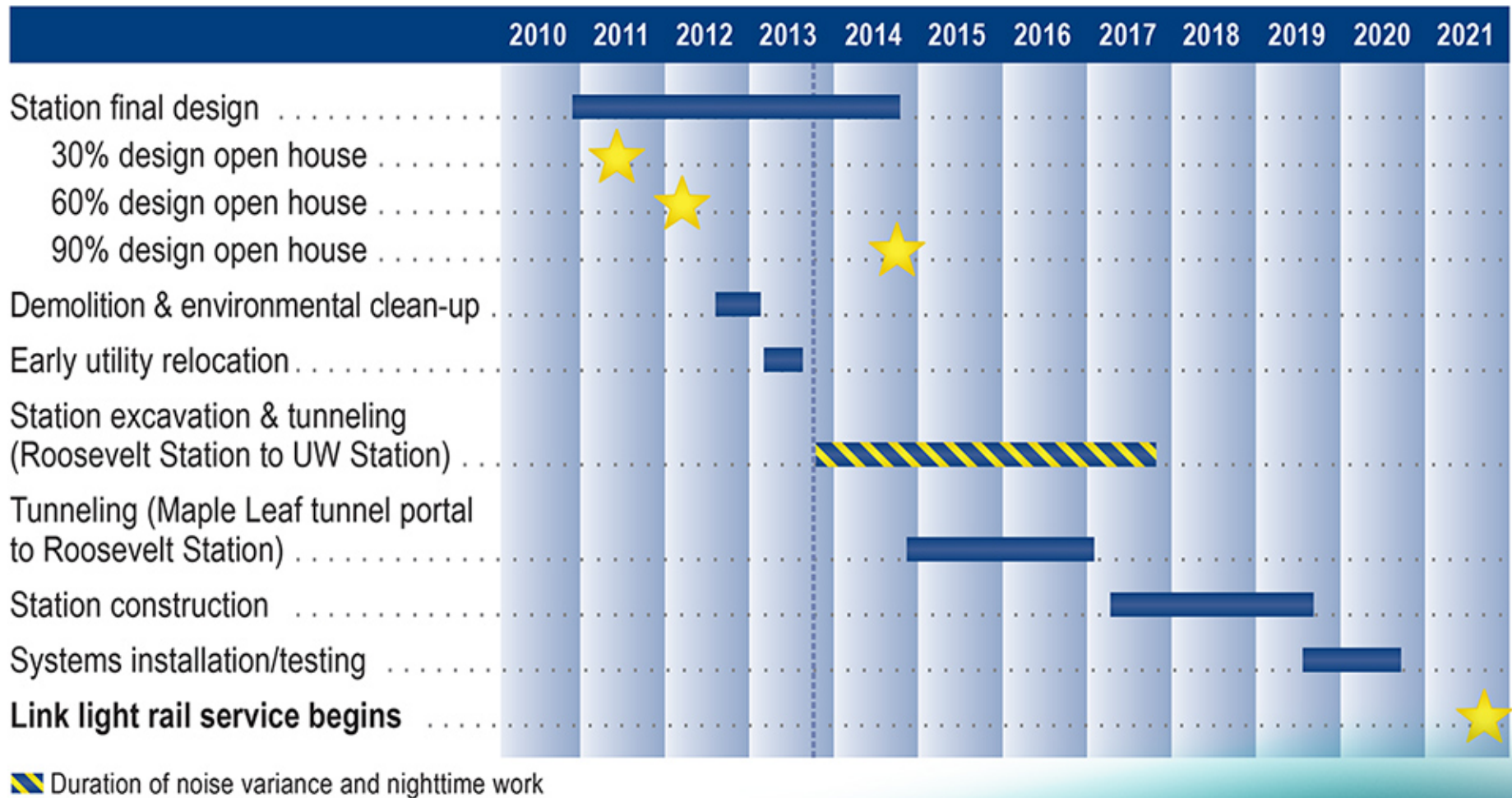
Roosevelt Station

Key Features



- Station platform 70'-90' underground
- Elevators, escalators and stairs at both entrances
- Bicycle parking
- Connections to buses on NE 65th St, 12th Ave NE and Roosevelt Way NE
- 8,000 daily boardings (2030)

Construction Work Done Salvage & Demolition

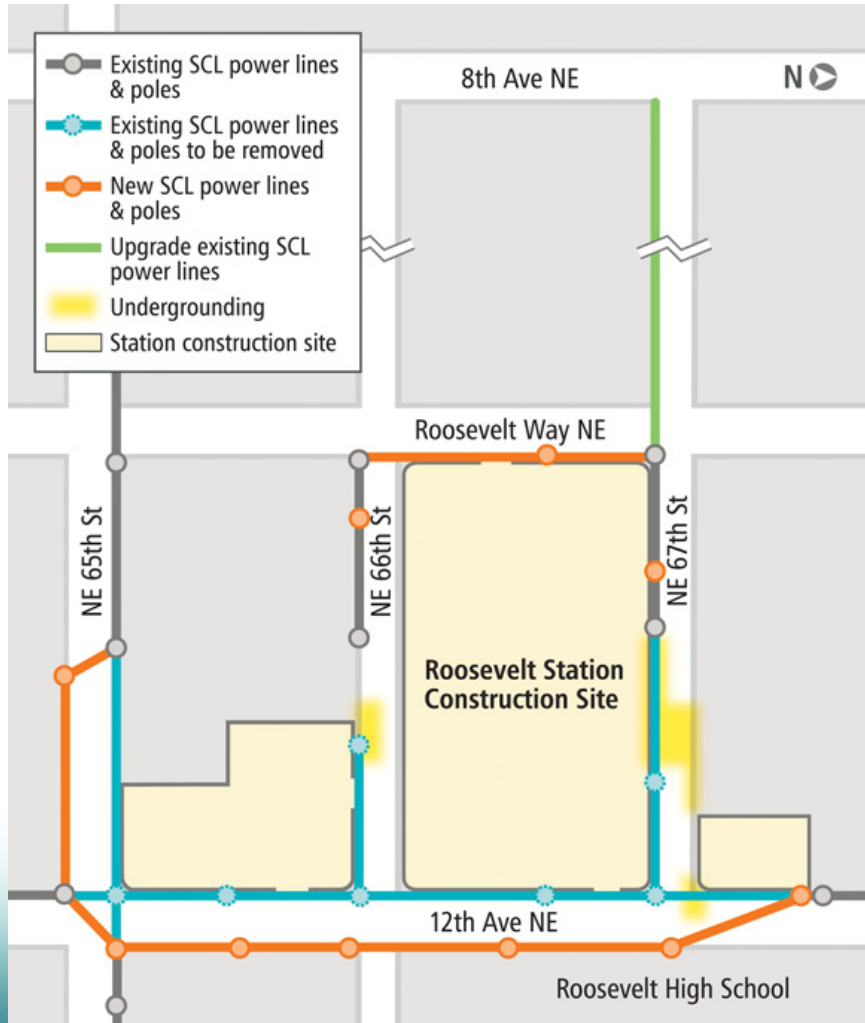


- Building fixtures & materials, Standard Radio façade salvaged

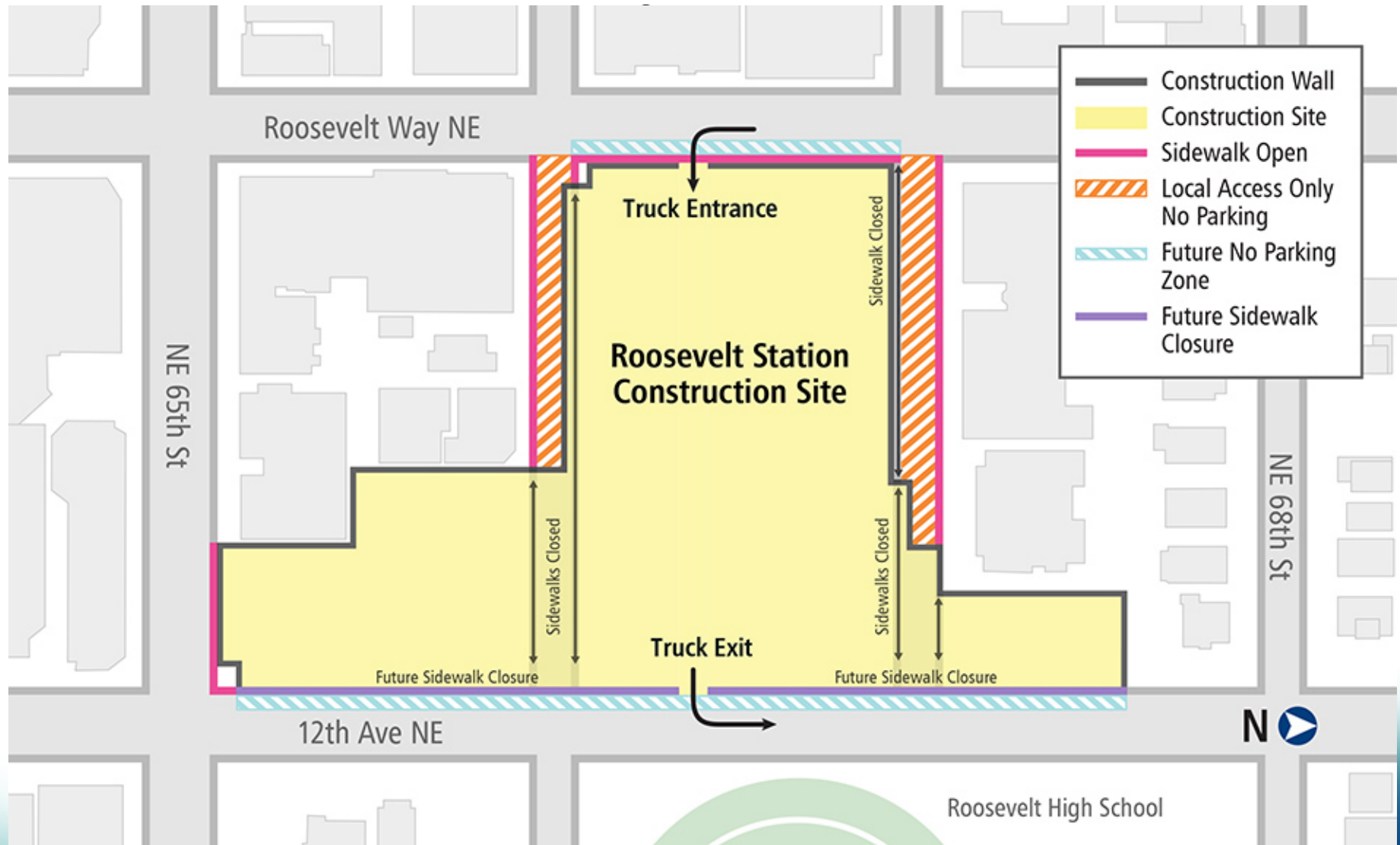

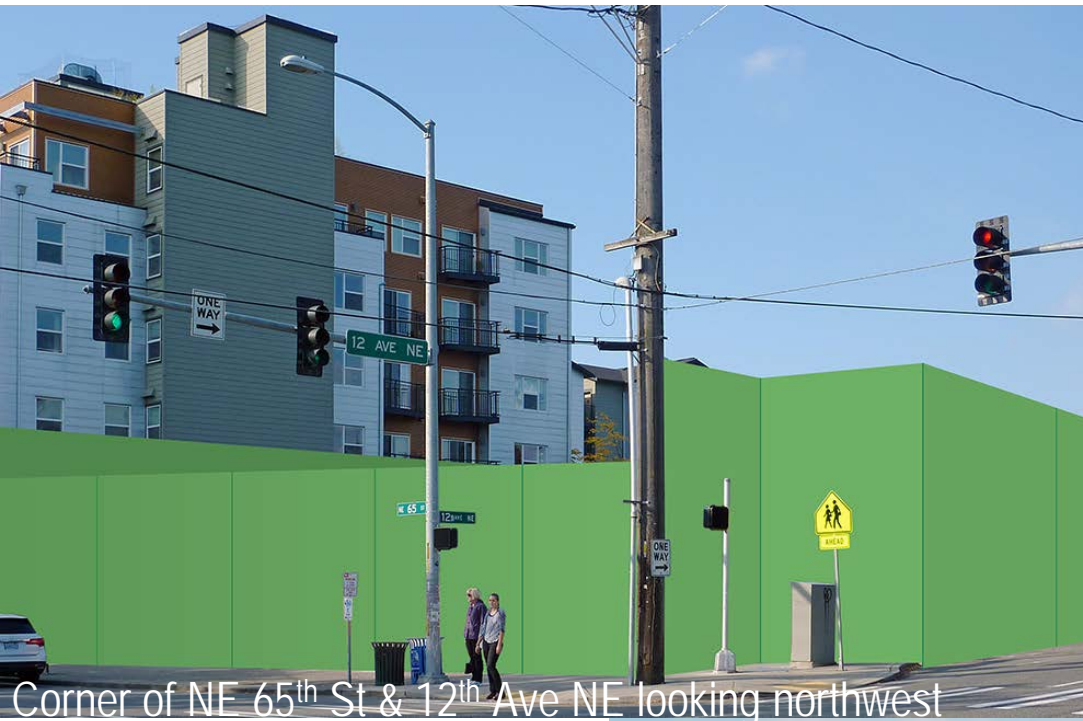

Upcoming Work

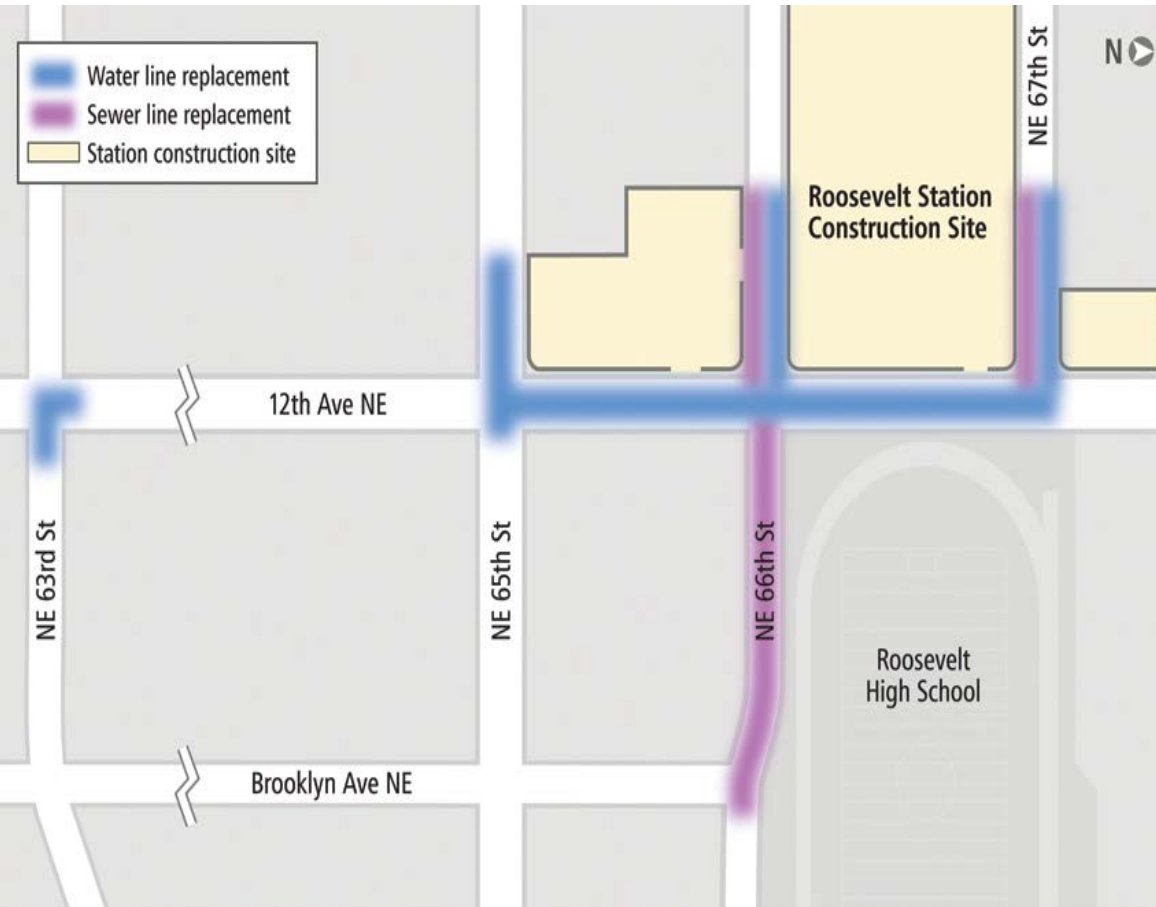
Now to Spring 2014



- Jet Grouting
 - Approximately 3 months of work
 - Daytime work only
 - No parking in this area during this work

Upcoming Work

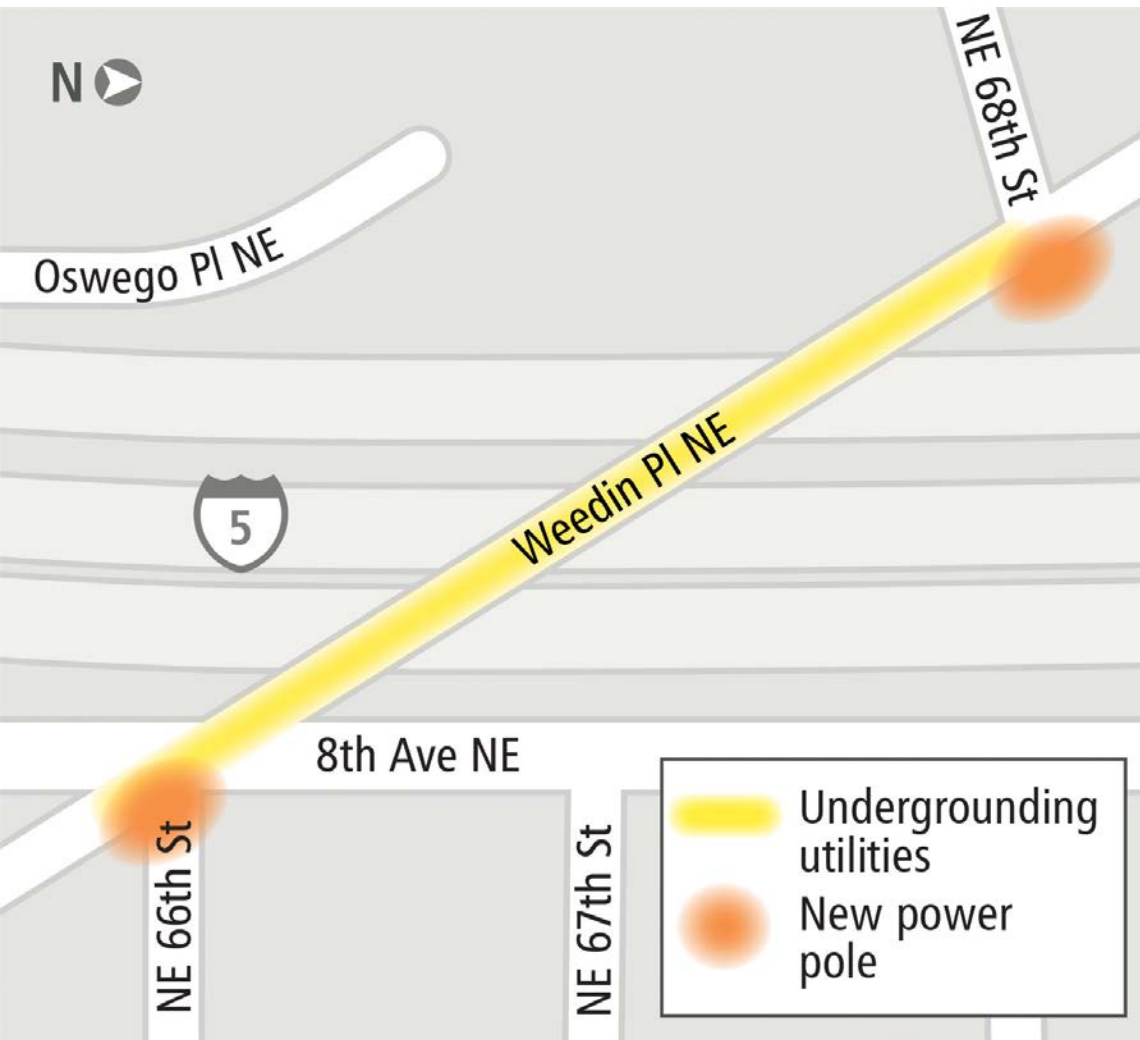
Now to Spring 2014



- 12th Ave NE, NE 65th St & NE 66th St
 - Lane closures
 - Traffic maintained
 - Detours for turns

Upcoming Work

Spring to Summer 2014

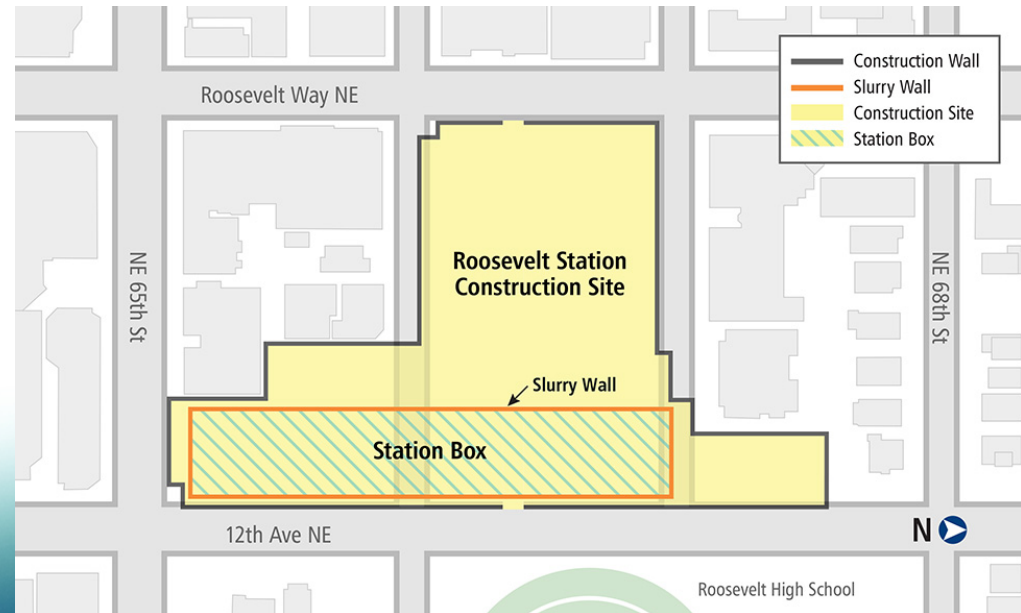


- Weedin Place
 - Second quarter 2014 start; lasts 3-4 months
 - Temporary sidewalk, parking, or lane closures
 - Traffic will be maintained

Upcoming Work

Now to End of 2014

- Slurry wall installation
 - Some equipment may operate at night; will comply with noise variance
- Station excavation
 - starts in mid-2014



Truck Route

(from north)

- Trucks enter site southbound from Roosevelt Way NE
- Trucks leave site northbound on 12th Avenue NE

- Trucks enter site southbound from Roosevelt Way NE
- Trucks leave site northbound on 12th Avenue NE



ST Standard Construction Procedures



- Standard provisions written into contracts
- Promote the local business district
- Full-time community outreach staff for neighborhood
- 24-hour construction hotline (888-298-2395)

Noise Mitigation

- Solid plywood construction wall
- Stationary equipment (compressors, generators) enclosed as needed
- Truck operations
 - No beeping alarms
 - Engine idle limit of 5 minutes
 - No compression brakes
 - Muck haul bins lined with noise dampening material
 - No nighttime hauling of “muck” (also known as “spoils”) unless approved by ST
- Monitoring
- Contractor incentive to reduce noise



Contractor Parking



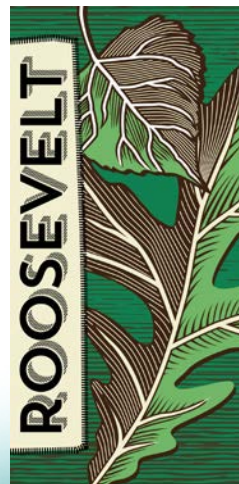
- Contractor workers not allowed to park on city streets
- Contractor responsible for finding parking lot(s) to accommodate all the workers
- ST leasing spaces from Diamond Parking at Calvary church for ST employee parking



Business Mitigation Marketing Program



- Roosevelt neighborhood banners hung on construction fencing
- Installed Roosevelt neighborhood street pole banners
- Roosevelt business map – November
- Install wayfinding kiosks – soon



Project Next Steps



- Hold neighborhood construction update meetings
- Station 90% design open house – fourth quarter 2014
- Surface work along tunnel route starts in 2015
- Sign up for construction alerts
