

# Link Light Rail System

- 16 miles of light rail with 13 stations currently in service
- University Link, S 200<sup>th</sup> Extension under construction; open 2016
- ST2 Plan funded extensions to Overlake, South King County and Lynnwood
- 54 mile system





# Northgate Link Extension (University District to Northgate)

- 4.3-mile light rail extension
- Stations: U District, Roosevelt and Northgate
- Open for service: 2021
- 62,000 daily boardings added to system by 2030





### Key Features:

- Station platform 75' 85' underground
- Elevators, escalators and stairs at both entrances
- Bicycle parking, Green Street
- Designed to accommodate future development
- Travel time to Westlake: ~ 8 minutes
- 12,000 daily boardings (2030)



### **U** District Station

- Site preparation
- Station box support and excavation
- Tunnel Boring Machine (TBM) launched
  from Roosevelt to U District
- TBM maintenance and ventilation to support drive to University of Washington Station

#### Stage 1 Overview:

Close Brooklyn Ave NE between NE 45<sup>th</sup> and NE 43<sup>rd</sup>

SOUNDTRANSIT

RIDE THE WAVE

- Close NE 43<sup>rd</sup> St between University Way NE and 12<sup>th</sup> Ave NE at the alleys
- One-way access north on Brooklyn Ave NE to east on NE 43<sup>rd</sup> St.
- Temporary sidewalk across NE 43<sup>rd</sup> St. (bicyclists dismount)
- UW Health Sciences Shuttle moves to 12<sup>th</sup> Ave NE


# Stage 1 Detail: NE 45<sup>th</sup> St and Brooklyn Ave NE

- No vehicle access to Brooklyn Ave NE south of NE 45<sup>th</sup>
- Sidewalks open to Neptune Theatre and UW Tower entrance
- Use crosswalks

Stage 1 Detail: NE 43<sup>th</sup> St and Brooklyn Ave NE

- Sidewalk along at U Manor
- Temporary sidewalk across NE 43<sup>rd</sup> St
- One way vehicle lane from Brooklyn to 43<sup>rd</sup>
- UW Shuttle on 12<sup>th</sup> Ave NE


(Early 2014 - Late 2014)



#### Stage 2 Overview:

- Full closure of Brooklyn Ave NE and NE 43<sup>rd</sup> St intersection for construction of temporary bridge
- New pedestrian pathway adjacent to the Varsity Arms (bicyclists dismount)
- Sidewalk and parking closures for water main work on NE 42<sup>nd</sup> St between Brooklyn Ave NE and University Way NE

 Temporary sidewalk and lane closures for water main work on NE 42<sup>nd</sup> St between Brooklyn Ave NE and University Way NE




#### Stage 3 Overview:





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### **ST Standard Construction Procedures**



- Standard provisions written into contracts
- Promote the local business district
- Full-time community outreach staff for neighborhood
- 24-hour construction hotline (888-298-2395)







### Noise Mitigation

- Solid plywood construction wall
- Stationary equipment (compressors, generators) enclosed as needed
- Truck operations No beeping alarms Engine idle limit of 5 minutes No compression brakes
- Monitoring
- Contractor incentive to reduce noise



### **Contractor Parking**





- Contractor workers not allowed to park on city streets
- Contractor responsible for finding parking lot(s) to accommodate all the workers
