 - T Line (Orange):** Connects Tacoma Dome to St Joseph, passing through Stadium District, S 4th, Old City Hall, Theater District, Convention Center, Union Station, Hilltop District, St Joseph, and Narrows.
 - N Line (Blue):** Connects Everett to Seattle, passing through Downtown Everett, Eastmont, South Everett, Ash Way, Canyon Park, Alderwood Mall, Lynnwood City Center, Mountlake Terrace, Edmonds, and Mukilteo.
 - S Line (Blue):** Connects Lakewood/Tacoma to Seattle, passing through Lakewood Transit Center, SR 512, Lakewood Station, DuPont, and Tacoma.
- Bus Routes:** Grey lines represent ST Express buses, with numbers indicating specific routes (e.g., 510, 512, 513, 515, 522, 532, 535, 542, 545, 550, 554, 556, 560, 566, 574, 577, 578, 580, 586, 590, 592, 594, 595, 596).
- Icons:** Various icons are placed along the routes to indicate Park & Ride locations, Ferry Terminals, Sea-Tac Airport, and Amtrak stations.
