



## Overlake Segment Fact Sheet

June 2015

### Overview

The Overlake Segment of East Link continues north from Bel-Red adjacent to SR 520, and will serve Overlake neighborhoods and businesses with two stations, Overlake Village and Redmond Technology Center.

Redmond Technology Center is the current terminus for the East Link Extension under ST2 funding; however, planning and environmental analysis to continue light rail on to downtown Redmond have been completed. Work will not continue until project funding is secured.



### Benefits

- Provides access to high quality, frequent transit service that operates 20 hours per day
- Supports the City of Redmond’s 152nd Corridor Study and Overlake Village Neighborhood Plan
- Accommodates future growth and planned transportation improvements
- Light rail will serve two stations and provide increased park-and-ride capacity at the Redmond Technology Center
- Pedestrian bicycle bridges at both stations span SR 520 to connect light rail stations to the surrounding community

### Travel times

(from Redmond Technology Center Station)

- International District/Chinatown: 30 minutes
- University of Washington: 40 minutes
- Bellevue Transit Center: 10 minutes
- Sea-Tac Airport: 65 minutes (with transfer at International District Station)

# Overlake Village Station

Located northwest of the intersection of NE 24th Street and 152nd Avenue NE the Overlake Village Station runs adjacent to SR 520. Riders will enter from the future Plaza Street, along 152nd Avenue NE. This station's design features two entrances, new bicycle and pedestrian connections, a passenger drop-off area, and is consistent with the City of Redmond's 152nd Corridor Study and Overlake Village Neighborhood Plan.

# Redmond Technology Center Station

Located along SR 520 at the current Overlake Transit Center site, the Redmond Technology Center Station is a major transit hub with connections between public transit and private transportation services. The station will feature a park-and-ride facility for approximately 300 vehicles, a covered facility for bicycles, and will improve pedestrian connections.
