



Downtown Redmond Link Extension

May 2017

The Downtown Redmond Link Extension builds new light rail from the Redmond Technology Center Station, opening in 2023, to downtown Redmond by 2024. Light rail will travel along SR 520 with two new stations in southeast Redmond, at Marymoor Park, and downtown Redmond. This project is part of the voter approved Sound Transit 3 Plan to add 50 more miles of light rail throughout the region.

How to get involved

Sound Transit is committed to working with the community to deliver the Downtown Redmond Link Extension on time and within budget. Preliminary design offers many opportunities for residents, neighborhood organizations, property owners and businesses to get involved. Community members are encouraged to comment on design concepts, potential environmental impacts, and more. Sound Transit will hold community meetings and events at key design milestones to inform and engage the public.



Project benefits

- 3.7 miles of new light rail service
- Two new light rail stations in downtown and southeast Redmond, near Marymoor Park
- Frequent, reliable service between Redmond, Bellevue, Seattle and the University of Washington, and other regional destinations
- Increased mobility, access and transportation capacity for residents and workers
- Open for service in 2024

Project history and schedule

2007-11

East Link Record of Decision

- Sound Transit completed environmental review and identified a preferred alternative*
- At-grade stations in southeast and downtown Redmond
- Train storage tracks
- Public scoping meetings, Draft Environmental Impact Statement hearings, and comment periods

2013

Board selected project to be built

- Two at-grade stations
- 1400 parking spaces
- Train storage tracks

2016

Sound Transit 3 approved by voters

- Two stations
- 1400 parking spaces
- System access improvements
- Bus/rail integration



*The 2007-2009 Great Recession reduced the projected ST2 tax revenues by approximately \$4.2 billion. In response, the Sound Transit Board removed these two stations from the East Link Extension project until funding could be identified.

2017

City of Redmond bus/rail transit integration study

- The City of Redmond completed a bus/rail transit integration study
- Final report recommended an elevated downtown Redmond station
- Open house and comment period

Conceptual engineering

- Sound Transit is refining conceptual design plans for the southeast Redmond and downtown Redmond stations and route from NE 40th Street to downtown Redmond
- Regular meetings with key stakeholders
- Community open house
- Sound Transit Board identifies proposed project refinements (June)

Design and real estate acquisition

- Sound Transit will advance preliminary engineering and design plans, including station and guideway design, right-of-way, trail connectivity, transit oriented development, and transit integration
