- Enhancements higher in 2021 driven by Digital Passenger Information Systems, Station Code Update, and Fare Paid Zone Clarity.
- State of Good Repair lower in 2021 as 2020 included significant spending (\$42M) for ST Express Fleet Replacement.

- Link: primarily new services at NGL, OMFE and DSTT.
- ST Express: costs reflect services to meet current ridership levels.
- Sounder: mainly due to scheduled overhaul and station maintenance, and insurance premium increase.
