- Motion 2018-164 to award the first contract
- Transition 3 outdated disparate systems to a unified, modern solution capable of supporting our future growth

A modern, flexible, enterprise solution supporting passenger communications across modes as well as future expansion





A Unified Passenger Experience

Across Modes

 Similar look and feel, similar information presented in the same way, whether on Link, Sounder, Tacoma Link (and in the future, BRT)



Across Channels

 Similar look and feel and the same sources of information whether looking at onboard signs, platform signs, website, or mobile devices

- Timely closer to real time information
- Accurate better arrival predictions


Operations

- Future Friendly supports system expansion, new modes and new information sources






Program Timeline








