 - \$50M Renton funding agreement;
 - 13-stall bus layover area
 - 6 bus bays (with canopy and shelter coverage)
 - Roadway improvements
 - Communications systems for real time signage
 - \$2M Bellevue funding agreement;
 - Lighting and signage improvements
 - Painting and pavement markings refresh
