

FY 2026 Overview – Expenditures




- Expansion Projects: Link shifts to spending on projects in planning, heavy Stride construction
- Modal Ops: Full year of Downtown Redmond and Federal Way; opening Crosslake Connection
- Service Delivery Program: Fund critical agency IT, SOGR, resiliency, and World Cup needs
- Debt service: Interest begins with drawdown of TIFIA loans; retirement of variable bonds in 2025

System Expansion Other 2026 Proposed Budget: \$45M



2026 Highlights:


- ➤ Innovation & Tech: Unified Control Center technology solutions, enhanced trip planning, and a faregate pilot.
- > ST Art: Fabrication of BRT art, installation at FWLE, and finish sounder garage art.
- > ST3 Planning: Long-range transit plan, ridership forecasting, and ST3 system plan.
- ➤ **TOD Planning**: Advancing joint development sites for Link projects in planning.
- ORCA Next Gen: PCI compliance and LIFT registry state of good repair.

Annual Trends - System Expansion Other Projects

3% projected decrease 2025 forecast to 2026 proposed budget

Major drivers include:

- ST Art
- Transit system access program
- Fare administration





Changes to Transit Improvement Plan: 2025 Adopted TIP to 2026 Proposed TIP

\$2.7M (0.4%) increase in total authorized dollars for system expansion – other



Debt Service

Debt Service 2026 Proposed Budget: \$230M

19% decrease from 2025

- Principal and interest on existing bonds and loans
- Interest on TIFIA loans for Pinehurst and Sounder Access draws
