Why we are here

- Provide an update on Sound Transit's public safety investments and regional coordination

Today, we are requesting a do-pass recommendation for Board approval of Resolution No. R2025-31 to transition the contracted Mobile Patrol services to full-time Sound Transit staff members of FAST.

Regional Transit Safety Task Force


Formed after 2024 King County Metro operator fatality, hundreds of stakeholders convened to improve safety and security on transit.

Public safety recommendations from Task Force plan, that ST is advancing this year:

- Faster response times
- Improve coordination with safety teams
- Increase visible security presence
- Data driven deployment
- Expand non-law enforcement options



Security Operations Center changes support Task Force Recommendations



In June 2025, Board approved internalization of the Security Operations Center to *improve response time* and *coordination*

- Transition ongoing, first cohort started mid-November
- "Text the SOC" marketing push underway

We have identified an additional opportunity to improve rapid-response by bringing a field-based security function in-house

Rapid Security Response: Mobile Patrols

Contracted service provider scope

Provides baseline security functions:

- Pre-set routes to pre-set checkpoints
- Walk platforms, augment station security as needed
- Maintaining visibility and awareness across the system

Some enhanced-level security functions:

- Incident response
- Service disruptions
- Hotspot and vulnerable location monitoring (e.g., copper theft prevention)



Field Activity Specialist Teams (FAST)

Employee rapid-response team improves passenger safety

Established in 2022, FAST provides rapid-response and on-site coordination between contracted security, law enforcement and other first responders.

- Currently a team of 10 monitors entire service area
- Manages an average of 70 incidents per month
- Performs service disruption, major event support
- Maintains system-wide situational awareness
- Provides field-based oversight of Security Contracts




Current staffing levels constrain providing consistent 24/7 system-wide coverage, limit response time.



Benefits of internalizing Mobile Patrol

Expanded FAST standardizes and professionalizes incident response

- Improve collaboration with our partner agencies and first responders.
- Increase coverage through zone-based deployment to improve response time.
- More robust performance measurement.
- Ongoing monitoring of entire service area
- Estimated \$84M+ Financial Plan cost savings compared to contracted resources
