



## Resolution No. R2020-09

A RESOLUTION of the Board of the Central Puget Sound Regional Transit Authority to recognize, thank and commend the Sound Transit and partner agency employees who are keeping everyone—especially essential workers—moving during this challenging time.

WHEREAS, the COVID-19 pandemic has severely disrupted our regional economy, employment, global and local travel, and the daily life of our region's people; and
