#### **ACTION**

Authorizes the Chief Executive Officer to execute a new interagency agreement with Pierce Transit for police security and comprehensive services for Tacoma Link Light Rail for a term of five years in the amount of \$870,287 with a 3% contingency of \$26,108 for a total authorized amount not to exceed \$896,395.

## **KEY FEATURES**

- The agreement term is five years starting 2005 and ending at the end of 2009.
- The scope of agreement contains comprehensive services for Tacoma Link Light Rail consistent with the previous agreement as follows:
  - As required by American Disability Association (ADA) Complementary Para-transit services
  - Refilling signage hardware and changeable information at Sound Transit facilities
  - Emergency bus support service for Tacoma Link
  - Insurance provisions
- The total estimated cost is \$896,395 including a 3% contingency and funds for additional service or special events.

#### **BUDGET IMPACT SUMMARY**

There is no action outside of the Board-adopted budget; there are no subarea impacts or funding required from other parties other than what is already assumed in the financial plan.

## **BUDGET DISCUSSION**

The Proposed 2005 Budget for Tacoma Link included \$174,300 for security. A 5% increase is assumed on the total for years 2006 through 2009 based on Tacoma Police cost increase, cost of living, and inflation. The security amount will be sufficient to cover the projected 2005 portion of this proposed agreement. The remaining four years of security costs will be included in the annual Tacoma Link budget over the life of the proposed agreement. No funds have been used or generated for either Para-transit or Supplemental Bus Service Funds and are not included in 2005.

#### REVENUE, SUBAREA, AND FINANCIAL PLAN IMPACTS

The proposed action is consistent with the current board-adopted budget and is affordable within Sound Transit's current long-term financial plan and the subarea financial capacity. There are no additional revenues associated with this action.
