# **PROJECT NAME**

Management Services Consulting contract with KJM/JTS, A Joint Venture

#### PROPOSED ACTION

Authorizes the Chief Executive Officer to execute a contract amendment with KJM/JTS (a joint venture), to exercise the remaining contract options for 24 months to provide agency-wide project control and support services in the amount of \$2,898,173, for a new total authorized contract amount not to exceed \$8,282,221.

#### **KEY FEATURES of PROPOSED ACTION**

- Provides management services in the area of agency-wide project control, cost estimating, scheduling, program progress reporting, and records management/document control support.
- The nature of the management services and agency-wide project support includes, but is
  not limited to, technical writing and editing for the creation of new procedural documents;
  support of regular and periodic updates to existing procedural and systems documentation;
  production and distribution of the agency's monthly progress report; and support of systems
  initiatives.
- This contract is structured to meet the changing needs of Sound Transit, and emphasizes
  as-needed, short-term consulting assignments to provide the expertise to deliver project
  solutions, peak-period assistance, and temporarily filling in for absent staff. The contract
  emphasizes task specific assignments and deliverables.
- The initial contract term was one year with eight six-month options to extend. If all options are exercised, the contract period will be for five years, from April 1, 2003 to March 31, 2008. The first four six-month options have already been exercised. This action would

authorize the exercise of the remaining four six-month options for an additional contract period of twenty-four months.

# **BUDGET IMPACT SUMMARY**

There is no action outside of the Board-adopted budget; there are no contingency funds required, no subarea impacts, or funding required from other parties other than what is already assumed in the financial plan.

# **BUDGET and FINANCIAL PLAN DISCUSSION**

The proposed action is consistent with the current adopted budget and is affordable within the agency's long-term financial plan and sub area financial capacity. The action will have no new revenue impact on Sound Transit.

The budget for this item is included in the agency administration budget of the applicable Link Light rail projects and the Project Delivery Support Services staff budget.

This contract amendment will have 100% M/W/DBE and Small Business participation.

The present KJM/JTS contract expires on March 31, 2006; however, the option to extend the scope and period of performance may be exercised.
