## PROJECT NAME

Bellevue Transit Center Rider Services Building

#### PROPOSED ACTION

Authorizes the chief executive officer to execute a contract amendment with Summit Central Construction, Inc., to provide additional construction services for the Bellevue Transit Center Rider Services Building project in the amount of \$35,000, for a new total authorized contract amount not to exceed \$1,680,050.

#### **KEY FEATURES of PROPOSED ACTION**

- The Bellevue Transit Center Rider Services Building project includes a new rider services center, plaza, landscaping, and artwork, all adjacent to the Bellevue Transit Center. Summit Central Construction Company, Inc. (SCCI) was awarded the construction contract for this project, which was completed in June 2006.
- This action is needed because of circumstances concerning the permit process for the Rider Services Building by the City of Bellevue.
  - The site of the Rider Services Building is between an office building to the west and a parking garage to the east.
  - The close proximity of the existing office and parking garage relative to the new Rider Services Building led the City of Bellevue to require the development of an "Alternative Materials and Methods" document (AMM), which was issued with the building permit.

- The AMM removes or modifies standard code requirements, adds some site specific requirements, and requires additional inspection, contractual agreements and processing.
- The differing code expectations complicated the City's permit inspections and delayed the contractor in completing the contract by about 29 calendar days, which cost SCCI an additional \$35,000.
- This contract amendment will allow the contractor to be paid and the contract to be closed out.

## **BUDGET IMPACT SUMMARY**

Current Project Phase: Construction Projected Completion Date: June 2006

There is no action outside of the Board-adopted budget; there are no contingency funds required, no subarea impacts, or funding required from other parties other than what is already assumed in the financial plan.

#### **BUDGET and FINANCIAL PLAN DISCUSSION**

The adopted 2007 budget for this project is \$3,500,928. The proposed action is to execute a contract amendment for construction services with SCCI. The Board adopted budget for the construction phase is \$2,434,292. The proposed action will result in a construction phase balance of \$495,849 and a project balance of \$788,480.

There are sufficient funds to complete this action. Committing these funds will not endanger any other project elements that are to be funded out of the overall project.

SCCI is the prime contractor for this contract. SCCI committed to a 20% Small Business participation goal with 15% M/W/DBE participation. To date, SCCI has achieved 100% Small Business participation, with actual M/W/DBE participation of 13.2%.
