PROJECT NAME

ST Express Fleet Replacement Program

PROPOSED ACTION

Amends the Adopted 2007 Budget for the ST Express Fleet Replacement Program to reflect an increase in the South King County portion of the program by \$2,000,000 and reducing the budget for the South King County portion of the ST Express Fleet Program by \$2,000,000.

KEY FEATURES of PROPOSED ACTION

- This proposed amendment would transfer \$2,000,000 from the South King County portion of the ST Express Fleet Program (#290) to the ST Express Fleet Replacement Program (#701).
- This action is needed to resolve an estimated funding shortfall for the South King County subarea portion of the ST Express Fleet Replacement Program (#701).

BUDGET and FINANCIAL PLAN DISCUSSION

The Adopted 2007 Budget included a total of \$105.2 million for the initial procurement of ST Express fleet (project #290, ST Express Fleet Program) and \$63.1 million for the replacement of the fleet through the period ending 2011 (project #701, ST Express Fleet Replacement Program). Through April 2007, a total of approximately \$91 million has been spent on the original fleet procurement. South King County has a remaining unspent balance in the Fleet Program of \$3.8 million. No transactions have been taken to the Board for fleet replacement.

In the 2007 budget, the ST Express Fleet Replacement Program included funding from Pierce County in the amount of \$22.0 million through 2011, with the amount from South King County to be determined. The South King County Subarea funding requirement for the near-term replacement of the Orion bus fleet is expected to total approximately \$1.6 million split between this procurement which covers seven of the 27 buses to be replaced and future replacements. Staff proposes that \$2.0 million be transferred from the ST Express Fleet Program (Project #290) into the Fleet Replacement Program (#701).

The proposed resolution would amend the Adopted 2007 Budget for the South King County portion of the ST Express Fleet Replacement Program (#701) to reflect a transfer from the South King County portion of the ST Express Fleet Program in the amount of \$2,000,000. As shown in the table below, the transfer would make the Adopted 2007 Budget for the South King County portion of the ST Express Fleet Replacement Program (#701) equal to \$2,000,000. The remaining lifetime budget of the ST Express Fleet Program from the South King County Subarea would be \$6.966.668.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION and BACKGROUND for PROPOSED ACTION

This amendment would allow for the acquisition of the first replacement of the ST Express fleet. The fleet being replaced is the 1994 Orion CNG bus fleet operated by Pierce Transit in support of South King County and Pierce County ST Express service. This replacement will be made up of two transactions: an acquisition of seven MCI high-capacity coaches that is being taken forward concurrent with this action and an acquisition of Gillig coaches, which will be brought to the Board for consideration later this year.

RESOLUTION NO. R2007-10

A RESOLUTION of the Board of the Central Puget Sound Regional Transit Authority amending the Adopted 2007 Budget for the ST Express Fleet Replacement Program to reflect an increase in the South King County portion of the program by \$2,000,000 and reducing the budget for the South King County portion of the ST Express Fleet Program by \$2,000,000.

WHEREAS, a Regional Transit Authority, hereinafter referred to as Sound Transit, has been created for the Pierce, King, and Snohomish County region by action of their respective county councils pursuant to RCW 81.112.030; and

WHEREAS, on November 5, 1996, at a general election held within the Central Puget Sound Regional Transit Authority district, the voters approved local funding for high capacity transit in the Central Puget Sound Region; and

WHEREAS, by Resolution No. R2006-24, the Sound Transit board adopted the 2007 budget on December 14, 2006; and

WHEREAS, the policy of the Sound Transit board has been to fund fleet purchases by the subareas served by the operating agency in proportion to the amount of service provided by that agency;

WHEREAS, the need has arisen for the replacement of 27 used buses operated on behalf of Sound Transit by Pierce Transit; and

WHEREAS, there is insufficient budget to fund fleet replacement in South King County; and

WHEREAS, said budget amendment is consistent with and affordable under Boardadopted financial policies as established by Resolution No. R72-1; and

WHEREAS, a two-thirds affirmative vote of the entire membership of the Sound Transit Board is required to amend the Adopted 2007 Budget.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of the Central Puget Sound

Regional Transit Authority that:

Section 1. The Adopted 2007 Budget is hereby amended to include a transfer of

\$2,000,000 from the ST Express Fleet Program (Project # 290) in the South King County

subarea to the ST Express Fleet Replacement Program (Project # 701) in the South King

County subarea.
