PROPOSED ACTION

Adoption of the Proposed 2008 Budget

KEY FEATURES of PROPOSED ACTION

The resolution approves the following operating expenditures for 2008:

- \$60.2 million for staff operations, including \$0.1 million for Community Development Fund administrative costs
- \$16.8 million for Transit Vision projects (Phase II Planning, and Fare Integration)
- \$0.2 million for Research and Technology
- \$0.7 million for Community Development Fund program payments
- \$95.1 million for transit operations in ST Express Bus
- \$50.5 million for transit operations in Sounder
- \$6.7 million for transit operations in Link
- \$1.2 million for Accessible Services
- \$36.3 million for payment of debt service on outstanding bonds
- \$0.2 million for Transit Oriented Development.
- \$0.4 million Public Art Program
- \$48.4 million for non-operating costs

In addition, the resolution authorizes the following capital outlays in 2008:

- \$65.9 million for Sounder
- \$442.2 million for Link
- \$57.3 million for Regional Express projects
- \$29.1 million for Service Delivery Capital

- \$2.2 million for the Public Art program
- \$22.2 million for the Capital Replacement Program
- \$1.2 million for administrative capital outlays
- \$0.9 million for Research and Technology
- \$1.5 million for Regional Fund Project Fare Integration

For the 2008 budget management, staff will continue providing quarterly briefings to the Audit and Reporting Subcommittee on progress to date. Based on the outcome of these briefings, quarterly budget amendments will be prepared for Board approval when appropriate.

BUDGET DISCUSSION

Sound Transit's Proposed 2008 Budget requests funding authorization totaling \$820,743,030 in operating expenditures and capital outlays. The agency's expenses and outlays will be funded by an estimated \$500,611,668 in revenue and other financing sources (on an accrual basis) and by an estimated positive cash position in January 2008 of \$600,000,000, assuming a \$550,000,000 bond sale in December 2007. Of this amount, an estimated \$286,195,724 will be collected from Retail Sales and Use Tax; \$77,149,820 from Motor Vehicle Excise and Car Rental Taxes; \$103,500,000 from federal grants; \$19,913,867 from farebox revenues; \$8,241,023 in interest earnings; and \$5,611,234 in miscellaneous revenues.

REVENUE, SUBAREA, AND FINANCIAL PLAN IMPACTS

The Proposed 2008 Budget is fully affordable within the agency's existing revenue projections and financial policies for Phase I.

RESOLUTION NO. R2007-25

A RESOLUTION of the Board of the Central Puget Sound Regional Transit Authority adopting an annual budget for the period from January 1 through December 31, 2008.

WHEREAS, a Regional Transit Authority, hereinafter referred to as Sound Transit, has been created for the Pierce, King, and Snohomish County region by action of their respective county councils pursuant to RCW 81.112.030; and

WHEREAS, on November 5, 1996, at a general election held within the Central Puget Sound Regional Transit Authority district, the voters approved local funding for high capacity transit in the Central Puget Sound Region; and

WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 72, adopted May 31, 1996, the Sound Transit Board adopted financial policies to govern the financing and implementation of the Ten-Year Regional Transit Plan and to specify budgetary guidelines for providing subarea equity in accomplishing the same; and

WHEREAS, by Motion No. 32 adopted on May 22, 1997, the Sound Transit Board approved the Implementation Guide, providing a blueprint for the development of significantly more detailed six-year capital and operating budgets for Sound Transit Board adoption; and

WHEREAS, by Resolution No. R2002-08 the Sound Transit Board adopted revised budget policies; and

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 72-1, adopted on April 13, 2006, rescinded Resolution No. 72 and amended the financial policies to include a strategic property acquisition program as an enumerated purpose of the Regional Fund; and

WHEREAS, the Sound Transit Chief Executive Officer submitted a proposed 2008 budget and amendments thereto for Board consideration; and

WHEREAS, said budget is consistent with and affordable under adopted Sound Transit financial policies as established by Resolution No. 72-1; and

WHEREAS, Sound Transit is successfully building and operating the first phase of the regional system that was approved by voters in 1996; and

WHEREAS, Sound Transit is meeting a high standard of public accountability through effective monthly progress reports and quarterly financial reporting; and

WHEREAS, a two-thirds affirmative vote of the entire membership of the Sound Transit Board is required to adopt the 2008 Budget.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of the Central Puget Sound Regional Transit Authority that:

Section 1. Subject to the provisions of Resolution No. 78-1 requiring Sound Transit Board approval of capital infrastructure projects, and Finance Committee or Board approval of contracts authorizing expenses exceeding \$200,000, Sound Transit is hereby authorized to incur \$60,151,776 in the year 2008 for staff operating expenses, including \$91,930 for Community Development Fund internal costs, \$16,780,231 for expenses for the Phase II Planning and Fare Integration projects, \$150,874 for the Research and Technology project, \$36,278,128 for payment of debt service on outstanding bonds, \$200,000 for Transit Oriented Development expenses, \$48,388,274 for non-operating costs and \$412,299 for STart expenses or such amounts as are contained in amendments to the Proposed Budget as adopted by the board. In addition, the Community Development Fund is authorized to incur \$700,000 for mitigation payments. Sound Transit is hereby authorized to incur \$700,000 for mitigation payments. Sound Transit is hereby authorized to incur \$709,794 in the year 2008 in expenses for transit operations for Regional Express, \$6,697,291 in expenses for transit operations for Link light rail, \$50,491,539 in expenses for transit operations for Sounder commuter rail, and \$1,189,753 for Accessible Services, or such amounts as are contained in

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amendments to the Proposed Budget as adopted by the Board. In addition, Sound Transit is hereby authorized to incur \$656,928,648 in the calendar year 2008 in capital outlays (including allocations); composed of \$57,313,289 in Regional Express, \$65,862,500 in Sounder Commuter Rail, \$442,185,958 in Link Light Rail, \$29,068,801 for Service Delivery capital, \$877,294 for the Research and Technology capital project and \$1,479,854 for the Fare Integration capital project, \$2,204,790 for the STart program, \$22,244,940 for the Capital Replacement Program, \$1,227,000 in administrative capital, or such amounts as are contained in amendments to the Proposed Budget as adopted by the board.

Section 2. The budget for the period January 1, 2008 to December 31, 2008 ("Adopted Budget"), as set forth in the proposed 2008 budget document (Attachment A) submitted to the Board in September 2007 and incorporated herein by reference, and the approved amendments thereto (Attachment B), is hereby adopted. The Adopted Budget projects the collection of \$500,611,668 in total revenues including \$363,345,544 in Sales and Use Tax and Motor Vehicle Excise Tax. The Adopted Budget is not an authorization of expenses, except as specified in Section 1 above. The Chief Executive Officer is authorized to conform and reformat the budget document as necessary to uniformly present the information, and to revise the Adopted Budget to correct nonmaterial errors.

Section 3. The Capital Plan described in Attachment A is hereby endorsed. Such endorsement does not constitute final project authorization, pursuant to Section 9.B. of Resolution No. 78-1.

Section 4. The Chief Executive Officer is authorized to amend the 2008 budget to allow for transfers between capital budget and operating budgets. With no net change in overall budgetary level, in order to comply with Generally Accepted Accounting Principles and Govern Accounting Standards Board pronouncements. Staff will report any such changes to the Board on a quarterly basis. Section 5. The Chief Executive Officer is authorized to amend the fiscal year 2008 budget reflected in the published Adopted 2008 Budget to reflect actual expenditures for 2007, including shifting of budget authority between 2007 and 2008 for projects anticipated to be completed in 2008, provided the adopted total lifetime budget is not changed.

<u>Section 6.</u> The Board directs the Chief Executive Officer, or her designee, to submit the final Adopted Budget to the Chair of the Board and the Chair of the Finance Committee to ensure that the amendments are accurately reflected therein.

<u>Section 7.</u> The Chief Executive Officer, or her designee, shall provide regular budget reports to the Sound Transit Board and shall provide the Board with such information as may be necessary to compare actual financial performance with the Adopted Budget and to ensure conformance with the financial policies.

<u>Section 8.</u> The Board further authorizes the Chief Executive Officer, or her designee, to take any actions necessary to implement the policies and determinations of the Board pursuant to this Resolution.
