PROJECT NAME

Central Link Initial Segment

PROPOSED ACTION

Authorizes the chief executive officer to increase the contingency for the contract with Carter & Burgess, Inc. to provide construction management services for Link Light Rail Segment C735, Rainier Valley Construction in the amount of \$264,734, for a new total authorized contract amount not to exceed \$13,645,672, including reimbursements of approximately \$666,048 to Sound Transit from third parties for betterments.

KEY FEATURES of PROPOSED ACTION

- The contract scope including this amendment includes: providing field and office support including office engineering, inspection, change order administration, management, and closeout support.
- The additional contract authority request is a result of an extended construction period. The contract amendment will support construction management services through the current construction completion plus a close out period. A change order to the construction management contract has been issued exercising a contract option to extend the time period for one year, through December 31, 2008.

BUDGET and FINANCIAL PLAN DISCUSSION

The Adopted 2008 Lifetime Capital Budget for the Central Link Initial Segment is \$2.07 billion. Within that amount, \$12,278,257 has been set aside for Sound Transit's share of C735 Rainier Valley Construction Management in the construction services phase. Since this amount is fully committed, the proposed action would result in a budget shortfall of \$701,367 for this line item, which will be funded from unallocated contingency within the construction services phase.

Within the construction services phase of the Initial Segment, \$1,000,000 has been set aside in the current-adopted budget for unallocated contingency. After commitments to fund shortfalls for other budget line items, a balance of \$701,367 remains in unallocated contingency. Use of \$436,633 of this amount was previously authorized to fund a budget shortfall for C735 Construction Management (Board Motion M2008-11 for Carter & Burgess, Inc., adopted 1/26/08). The proposed action would authorize use of the \$264,734 balance, leaving no unallocated contingency remaining in the construction services phase.

The current authorized not to exceed amount for the Carter & Burgess, Inc. contract includes betterments for which Sound Transit will be reimbursed by third parties in the amount of approximately \$666,048, including reimbursement from Seattle Housing Authority (SHA), as authorized by Board Motion M2006-70 (approved 10/5/06). Sound Transit's share of this contract would be limited to \$12,979,624.

The proposed action is consistent with the current adopted budget, and is affordable within the agency's long-term financial plan and subarea financial capacity. The action will have no new revenue impact on Sound Transit.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION and BACKGROUND for PROPOSED ACTION

In November 2001, the Board selected an initial segment of Central Link to be constructed from downtown Seattle to South 154th Street in Tukwila. Construction along MLK Jr. Way South includes 4.5 miles of at-grade light rail guideway; and the Columbia City (Edmunds), Othello, and Rainier Beach (Henderson) Stations.

In December 2003, Sound Transit identified RCI-Herzog as the best value proposer for the C735 - Rainier Valley Construction procurement. RCI-Herzog's proposed baseline schedule projected completion of the work in January 2007.

In January 2004, Sound Transit issued Notice to Proceed (NTP) to the Carter & Burgess contract for construction management services for the C735 - Rainier Valley Construction project. Services include providing resident engineering, office engineering, inspection (civil, structural, electrical, track, mechanical, and utilities), change order administration, safety inspection, management, and diversity. The original contract was scheduled to end in December 31, 2006. Two contract change orders have been executed to exercise the two one-year options to extend the contract through December 31, 2008.

In February 2004, Sound Transit issued NTP1 for preconstruction work to RCI-Herzog, with a contractual completion date of April 2007. Construction management services are provided by Carter & Burgess.

In July 2004, Sound Transit issued NTP2 for the remaining work to RCI-Herzog. Soon after NTP2 was issued, additional staff was mobilized as a result of many factors including the need to enhance the quality assurance inspections and manage increased contract documentation.

In July 2006, RCI-Herzog submitted a revised baseline schedule projecting work to be completed in October 2007 with the current construction completion of 48%.

In August 2006, the Board approved Motion No. M2006-62 authorizing additional funds for the construction management contract with Carter Burgess.

Earlier this year, the Board authorized Motion No. M2008-11 authorizing additional funds for construction management of the Rainier Valley segment.

In June 2008, RCI-Herzog forecasted a completion of September 2008. Sound Transit has not changed the contractual completion date from April 2007 and the responsibilities for the delay are not yet resolved. The construction contractor delays beyond April 2007 are subject to Liquidated Damages in the amount of \$10,000 per day.
