## **PROJECT NAME**

Link Light Rail, Sounder Commuter Rail, and Regional Express Bus Capital Projects

## PROPOSED ACTION

Authorizes the chief executive officer to execute a five-year contract with Pacific Northwest Title to provide on-call title and escrow services for real property acquisitions, support for property management, and transit oriented development for a total authorized contract amount not to exceed \$460,000.

## **KEY FEATURES of PROPOSED ACTION**

- This contract defines a scope of work, including providing initial title reports, title insurance, title research, and escrow services for real property acquisitions for Link light rail, Sounder commuter rail, and Regional Express bus service.
- The purpose of this action is to establish a contract for title and escrow services to cover current and future services needed for ST2, remaining Sound Move real property acquisitions, and to support property management and transit oriented development title and escrow functions and activities.
- The proposed contracts replace the current escrow and title services agreement that expired December 31, 2009.
- Sound Transit issued a Request for Proposal for these on-call title and escrow services that allowed for award of two contracts. This approach accommodates the amount and flow of work required to support real property acquisitions over the next five years. Chicago Title Insurance is the other firm selected.

## **BUDGET IMPACT SUMMARY**

There is no action outside of the Board-adopted budget; there are no contingency funds required, no subarea impacts, or funding required from other parties other than what is already assumed in the financial plan.

## **BUDGET and FINANCIAL PLAN DISCUSSION**

This on-call services contract will be used for Link light rail, Sounder commuter rail, and ST Express bus capital projects. Services may also be utilized by Operations, subject to budget funding in the future.

The proposed ongoing services for ST2 and remaining Sound Move projects would be assigned by task order within each project. Budget is to be identified and committed prior to a task order being approved to ensure that the total contract amount does not exceed the amount authorized by the Sound Transit Finance Committee. Since the proposed services will be assigned on an as-needed basis, the distribution of costs will be determined as project schedules and budgets are established. Work under these contracts will be authorized as the Board approves individual project budgets for property acquisition.

The proposed action is consistent with the Adopted 2010 Budget, and is affordable within the agency's current long-term financial plan and subarea financial capacity. The action will have no new revenue impact on Sound Transit.

## **SMALL BUSINESS PARTICIPATION**

Sound Transit determined that because of the specific nature of the services to be provided under this contract, joint venturing and/or subcontracting would be unlikely. Therefore, proposers were not required to submit a plan for small business participation.

Pacific Northwest Title will perform 100% of the assigned work.

## PROJECT DESCRIPTION and BACKGROUND for PROPOSED ACTION

In order to implement ST2 projects and remaining Sound Move projects it will be necessary for Sound Transit to continue to acquire real property. This contract will allow Sound Transit to complete future Link light rail, Sounder commuter rail, and ST Express bus service acquisitions for various projects. Current and future Link work includes completing Initial Segment property acquisitions work, Airport Link, University Link, as well as for other projects identified for ST2.

Pacific Northwest Title will provide initial title reports, title insurance, title research, and escrow services for real property acquisitions undertaken by Link light rail, Sounder commuter rail, and ST Express bus service.

## **CONSEQUENCES of DELAY**

Sound Transit anticipates property acquisitions will begin in early 2010 for ST2 projects. Because of the aggressive schedule, a delay in approval could result in a delay in the completion of right of way acquisition potentially delaying contract awards.
