PROPOSED ACTION

Authorizes the chief executive officer to execute a one-year contract with four one-year options to extend with AtWork! to provide landscaping services for Sound Transit owned properties for a total authorized contract amount not to exceed \$913,185.

KEY FEATURES SUMMARY

- The proposed contract is for landscaping services for the properties maintained by Sound
 Transit that are not currently being used for construction or revenue service. The services are
 necessary to maintain a neat appearance, provide pest control, and improve property access
 and security.
- The scope of work includes regular scheduled mowing, pruning, trimming and trash pick-up, as well as unscheduled landscaping such as plant replacement, plant removal, and arborist services for properties.
- A limited notice to proceed has been issued in order for work to begin in September 2013 to ensure no lapse in service between the current contract and this new contract.
- The contract amount requested covers the one-year contract and four one-year options.
- Sound Transit has a separate contract for landscaping services for properties that are in revenue service.

BACKGROUND

Sound Transit manages and maintains approximately 200 properties for Sounder, Link, and Regional Express that are being held until construction begins, are not in revenue service, or are awaiting future action including over 22 miles of railroad right-of-way owned by Sound Transit.

The contract amount anticipates an increase in the number of properties being maintained over the next five years as new properties are acquired for ST2.

The contract was advertised as a Request for Proposals in July 2013 and seven proposals were received. AtWork! was the top-ranked firm offering the best value to Sound Transit.
