PROPOSED ACTION

Authorizes the chief executive officer to execute a five-year contract with ten additional one-year options with OTB Solutions Group, LLC and/or its assignees for the Safety and Security Certification Management System in the amount of \$1,301,828, with a 10% contingency of \$130,182 for a total authorized contract amount not to exceed \$1,432,010.

KEY FEATURES SUMMARY

- Under this contract, the vendor will supply AgilePoint software as a service (SaaS) product, licensing, training and support for agency wide business process management including the Safety and Security Certification Management System.
- The proposed solution will be deployed initially for the Safety and Quality Assurance (SQA)
 Division Safety and Security Certification Program. Once the Safety and Security Certification
 Program is developed and implemented, the proposed solution will subsequently be offered as
 an agency-wide platform for use by other departments at Sound Transit.
- The AgilePoint tool will expedite operational processes and procedures by:
 - Providing a Safety and Security Certification Management Database to track and maintain all certifiable scope of Sound Transit projects from the Preliminary Engineering phase to Pre-Revenue Service;
 - Automating the certification process for the East Link Extension, Northgate Link Extension, and Lynnwood Link Extension; as well as future capital projects;
 - Allowing easy implementation of rules and requirements to meet new FTA requirements;
 - Improving coordination between Sound Transit Design, Engineering & Construction Management, Operations, and Security functions;
 - o Improving access to supporting documents; and
 - Providing invoice processing and approval automation capabilities, and automating the records management archival and retrieval process for safety and security certification work.
- Once the database is built, additional configurations can be used to provide additional process automation in support of Records Management, Financial Invoicing and Procurement and Contracts.
- The amount requested includes the design, testing, development, installation and user training, as well as annual license subscription costs, for the first five years. Additional funding for the option years would require Board approval.

BACKGROUND

Safety and Security Certification is required for all Sound Transit Facilities prior to opening for public use. The initial deployment of the proposed solution would replace the current system used

to manage the safety and security certification process. The current process utilizes Microsoft Access and requires manual and often redundant entry of data resulting in rework.

The system will be used to develop applications, processes and reports to support Sound Transit safety certification program processes. The system will be used by Sound Transit's internal staff and by Sound Transit's external contractors and sub-contractors and other regulatory government agencies with responsibilities towards safety requirements and certification programs.

With the purchase of additional user licenses, the AgilePoint tool will provide a flexible platform to automate workflow management that can be applied to other areas of Sound Transit operations including records management, financial invoicing, procurement and contracts.

In March 2015, Sound Transit solicited proposals for the Safety and Security Certification Management System through a competitive Request for Proposals. In the RFP, Sound Transit requested that the proposed solution also serve as an agency-wide platform for use by other departments at Sound Transit. Three firms submitted a total four proposals. OTB Solutions Group, LLC was determined to be the firm that best met the evaluation criteria, offered the best value and is in the best interest of Sound Transit.

FISCAL INFORMATION

This action authorizes the procurement of a hosted business process automation platform on a subscription basis. Initially, it will automate the safety and security certification process associated with the identified Link light rail capital projects. The software platform has capacity and scalability to add additional processes as time and resources allows. The focus will begin on the Link light rail projects but a portion of the contract authorization is to provide for additional process improvements during the contract period. Additional work will be funded through the Finance and Technology Budget (FIT) under the IT Division and included in future years budget development processes.
