- Expert Review Panel coordination (on-going)
- Board member briefings
- Direction regarding project refinements and near-term improvements (Quick wins)
- Complete Spine:
o LRT to Tacoma, Everett, Downtown Redmond
- Extend LRT to Ballard and West Seattle
- Bus Rapid Transit:
o I-405
o SR 522/145 ${ }^{\text {th }}$
- South Sounder capital improvements
- Tacoma Link extension
- ST Express service
- Funding programs: TOD Planning, Innovation, and System Access
- Advancing next logical steps: ST4 and HCT corridor planning
- Operations and maintenance facilities for bus and rail
