

# Mid-Year 2017 Budget Amendment Summary

May 2017



### **Budget Actions to Begin ST3 Implementation**

- Board adopted 2017 Budget in December 2016:
  - Budget reflected near-term budget changes for ST3.
  - CEO indicated mid-year budget amendment forthcoming.
- Proposed mid-year 2017 Budget Amendment:
  - \$3.8 million increase in operating budget to mobilize for ST3.



#### Mid-year Budget Amendment to Mobilize ST3 - \$3.8 million

- Amendment to adopted 2017 budget \$3.8 million:
  - 74 new positions \$2.5 million cost in 2017.
  - HR recruiting support contracts and advertising \$630,000.
  - Downtown Transportation Association dues \$125,000.
  - IT hardware, software, and communication costs \$523,879.

2017 Operating Budget increased from \$407.1 to \$410.9 million

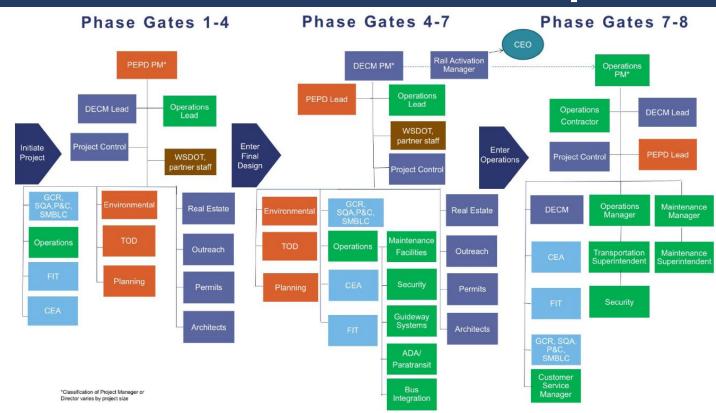

#### **HR Recruiting Support Contracts and Advertisements**

- Recruiting firm contracts \$430,000
- Recruitment advertising \$200,000
- Assist Human Resources staff with 2017 recruiting effort.
- Approximately 154 new positions will be added in 2017.
- Vacancies will need to be filled due to retirements, transitions, and staff leaving the agency.



#### **Downtown Transportation Association Dues**

- Downtown Transportation Association Dues \$125,000.
- Membership key to developing strong relationships with downtown Seattle stakeholders.
- Downtown Seattle stakeholders are critical to the One Center City effort and Ballard to West Seattle project getting underway in 2017.



#### Hardware, Software and Communications Costs

- IT hardware, software, and communication costs \$523,879
- Computers, including engineering hardware desktops for consultants, all software, peripherals, and communication costs.
- Setup for new ST3-related FTEs and consultants.



#### **Additional Board Actions in 2017**

- Proposed 2018 Budget
  - Additional ST3 staff resources.
  - Bringing initial ST3 projects "on budget".
- Fall 2017 Financial Plan Review
  - Includes combined Sound Move/ST2/ST3 consolidated program costs.
  - Initial total costs estimated at \$88 billion for capital, operating, debt service and other costs 2017-2041.
