### **Kent Station and Garage Stair Towers Repainting Contract**

#### PROPOSED ACTION

Authorizes the chief executive officer to execute a contract with Long Painting Company to provide painting services for Kent Station and Garage Stair Towers in the amount of \$205,318, with a 10% contingency of \$20,532, for a total authorized contract amount not to exceed \$225,850, contingent upon resolution of any protest received.

### **KEY FEATURES SUMMARY**

- Under the contract, Long Painting Company will repaint the four parking garage stair towers, two station platform stair towers, and spot paint a pedestrian bridge. Painting is needed about every ten years to meet or exceed the intended useful life of a structure.
- The scope of work includes:
  - o Labor and materials, removal of rust, sealing, and repainting.
  - Work includes stairs, handrails, landings, roof structures and section support beams at the pedestrian bridge.
- Rust removal is required due to water intrusion below the existing painted surface in a few specific areas.
- Since the work will be performed near an active railroad, some flagging services and safety training are included in the contract scope.

#### **BACKGROUND**

Approximately 40 percent of Sound Transit facilities were opened for service over 10 years ago. All of these facilities will require rehabilitation and repair in order to meet or exceed the intended useful life of the various components. The work that typically needs to be done at the 10 year mark includes asphalt overlay, resealing, restriping, caulking, repainting, replacement of doors, major tile replacement, and HVAC replacement.

The scope of work for this contract includes labor and materials to repaint the four stair towers within the Kent parking garage; two stair towers at the Kent Station pedestrian bridge, and portions of the pedestrian bridge structure. The work includes the stairs, handrails, landings, roof structures and spot painting on the tube steel section support beams at pedestrian bridge.

The stairs are constructed of steel stringers and pans with concrete in-fill treads with metal nosing. Water has seeped into the joints where metal meets concrete and has caused rusting to the metal components. While not a structural concern yet, it is unsightly and could become one eventually.

The completed rust removal, sealing and repainting will eliminate water intrusion and subsequent rust and rust staining, extending the useful life of the stair towers and pedestrian bridge.

### PROCUREMENT INFORMATION

An Invitation for Bids was released on May 2, 2017. Five bids were received on May 24, 2017. After review of the bidding documents, it was determined that the lowest bid was submitted by Long Painting Company in the amount of \$205,318. Further documentation was requested from Long Painting Company and they were determined to be the lowest responsible bidder.

### **FISCAL INFORMATION**

The proposed action will be funded from the Services category within the Operations department's annual operating budget. The Service category budget is \$60,781,989, of which a total of \$225,850 is estimated to be spent in the current year of the contract and is within the agency's budget authority. After approval of this action, the remaining annual budget amount will be used to fund other department expenditures anticipated in the 2017 annual budget.
