Systemwide Electrical Preventative Maintenance Contract Amendment

PROPOSED ACTION

Authorizes the chief executive officer to execute a contract amendment with Seahurst Electric, Inc. to provide electrical preventative maintenance services at Union Station in the amount of \$24,900, for a new total authorized contract amount not to exceed \$437,265 plus applicable taxes.

KEY FEATURES SUMMARY

- This action adds Union Station to the existing Systemwide Electrical Preventative Maintenance contract that was approved by the Operations and Administration Committee on March 1, 2018.
- The amendment consolidates all of Sound Transit's system preventative electrical maintenance into one single contract to better manage the overall effort.
- The scope of work includes de-energized testing, energized testing, evaluation of existing conditions and on-call services for required repairs discovered during testing.
- The total authorized not-to-exceed amount covers the current one-year contract plus three option years.
- The systemwide contract allows Sound Transit to add/delete facilities as needed.
- Applicable taxes for this amendment are currently estimated to be \$2,515; applicable taxes for the total contract are estimated to be \$44,164.

BACKGROUND

As Sound Transit's services have grown, modal facilities, such as stations and transit centers, have been added. These facilities have electrical systems that provide power for lighting, security monitoring, display signage, and ticket vending machines. As with any infrastructure system, timely and thorough inspection and maintenance will assist in preserving and prolonging the ability of the electrical system to perform as intended.

In 2015, Sound Transit established an electrical preventative maintenance program for its main office structure, Union Station. The agency has also conducted an extensive inventory of its complete modal electrical systems. The systemwide preventative maintenance program was modeled after Union Station's, to thoroughly inspect each modal facility's electrical system; make recommendations for any repairs indicated; and establish a routine inspection to expose potential issues before they impact Sound Transit's stations' functionality and customer experience.

In March 2018, the systemwide electrical preventative maintenance agreement was awarded to Seahurst Electric, Inc. At that time, Union Station was on the last year of a separate preventative maintenance contract. This action brings all Sound Transit facilities under the same electrical maintenance contract.

PROCUREMENT INFORMATION

This contract is the result of a Request for Proposals where Seahurst Electric, Inc. submitted the single proposal received. Staff negotiated a price reduction of \$188,680 or 31% for the contract award. Seahurst Electric, Inc. has been successfully performing this work on this and a previous contract for a similar Scope of Work.

FISCAL INFORMATION

Operations (in thousands)

The proposed action will amend the current contract by \$24,900 plus applicable taxes for a new total authorized contract amount not to exceed \$437,265 plus applicable taxes and will be funded from the Services category within the Operations Department's annual operating budget. The Services category budget is \$67,956,749, of which a total \$273,803 is estimated to be spent for this contract in 2018 and is within the agency's budget authority. After approval of this action, the remaining annual budget amount will be used to fund other department expenditures.

Funding for the additional year of the contract will be included in the 2019 annual budget request.
