PROPOSED ACTION

Authorizes the chief executive officer to execute a contract amendment with Securitas Security Services USA, Inc. to provide a four month contract extension, from August 31, 2018 to December 31, 2018, for system-wide security services in the amount of \$4,400,000, for a new total authorized contract amount not to exceed \$45,822,000.

KEY FEATURES SUMMARY

- Sound Transit is currently in the middle of a procurement process for the next generation of
 contracted security. The procurement process was delayed due to questions relating to the
 responsibility of securing the Downtown Seattle Transit Tunnel and forecasting for future
 expansions under Sound Transit's Capital System Expansion Implementation Plan.
- This contract extension will allow for Sound Transit to complete the competitive procurement process; allow for any necessary transition in security contracts; and align the contractual year with Sound Transit's budget year.
- This contract extension will be effective from August 31, 2018 to December 31, 2018.

BACKGROUND

The Securitas contract provides security services for approximately 60 facilities in King, Pierce, and Snohomish counties and for Sounder, Link, and Tacoma Link services. This contract currently excludes security for facilities and service covered by existing partner agreements, i.e. the Downtown Seattle Transit Tunnel, Tacoma Dome Station, and ST Express bus service.

The Securitas contract includes 112 transit security officers, 22 fare enforcement officers, 8 dispatch officers, and 20 supervisors and managers. They cover security in three areas:

- The <u>Transit Security Unit</u> provides customer service, inspection of critical infrastructure, uniformed presence and patrols for Link, Sounder, Tacoma Link, and ST Express facilities.
- The <u>Fare Enforcement Unit</u> provides customer service, security, and fare inspection on Link and Sounder service.
- The <u>Security Operations Center</u> provides 24/7 dispatch and security phone response for Sound Transit customers and employees with safety or security concerns. The SOC also serves as a hub for information to Station Agents and Security personnel during service interruptions and monitors CCTV and Customer Emergency Call Stations.

In addition, contracted security officers provide as needed services to various Sound Transit business units such as Property Management, Community Outreach, and the different Capital Project teams.

FISCAL INFORMATION

The proposed action will amend the current contract by \$4,400,000 for a new total authorized contract amount not to exceed \$45,822,000 and will be funded from the Services category within Operations Department's annual operating budget. The Services category budget is \$67,956,749, of which a total \$11,230,680 is estimated for this contract in 2018 (YTD spending of \$2,930,359 and estimated spending for the rest of 2018 of \$8,300,321) and is within the agency's budget authority. After approval of this action, the remaining annual budget amount will be used to fund other department expenditures in 2018.
